SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2375 by House Committee on Appropriations

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2375 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, any school student athlete who has been removed from a sport competition or practice session cannot return to the competition or practice until the student is evaluated by a health care provider licensed by the State Board of Healing Arts. Before returning, the student is required to obtain a written clearance from the health care provider. HB 2375 would add licensed chiropractors, optometrists, advanced practice registered nurses, and physician assistants to the definition of "health care providers."

Enactment of HB 2375 would have no fiscal effect on state government.
