
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2445 by House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2445 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2445 would clarify that discovery materials in criminal proceedings are to be provided to the “defense” rather than only the “defendant.”
