
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2620 by House Committee on Education

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2620 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2620 would require local boards of education to receive written consent from a parent or legal guardian before instruction on health and human sexuality is given to a student. The local board of education would be required to provide all instructional materials on health and human sexuality when requested by a parent or legal guardian before a decision is made to allow the student to be provided health and human sexuality instruction.

Enactment of HB 2620 would have no fiscal effect on the state budget.
