
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2634 by House Committee on Corrections and Juvenile Justice

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2634 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2634 would prohibit prosecution of juveniles less than 14 years of age as adults.

The Department of Corrections indicates that HB 2634 would have no fiscal effect on agency operations and no effect on adult and juvenile bed space figures. According to the Office of Judicial Administration, the bill would have no fiscal effect on the Judicial Branch.
