SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 151 by Senate Committee on Ethics, Elections and Local Government

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 151 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 151 would set term limits of 12 total years for members of the United States Senate and United States House of Representatives representing the State of Kansas. Senators would be limited to two consecutive six-year terms and Representatives would be limited to six consecutive two-year terms.

The Office of the Secretary of State indicates that passage of SB 151 would have no fiscal effect.
