SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 248 by Senator Faust-Goudeau

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 248 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 248 would require, whenever feasible, that notice be given to any crime victim at least 14 working days prior to the release of any inmate on parole, conditional release, expiration of sentence or postrelease supervision who committed crimes against the victim.

The Department of Corrections reports that passage of SB 248 would have no fiscal effect on victim services operations. The bill would put into law a procedure that is currently practiced by the Department.
