SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 277 by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 277 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, a school district's local option budget (LOB) is computed using a base state aid per pupil of (BSAPP) \$4,433, or the actual BSAPP, whichever is greater. This current method of calculating the LOB is currently set to sunset on June 30, 2014. SB 277 would extend the sunset date to June 30, 2019.

Enactment of SB 277 would not change current levels of LOB state aid to school districts, which are established in the budget. The current appropriation for LOB state aid is not at the \$4,433 level.
