
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 320 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 320 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 320 would allow the Emergency Medical Services Board to impose fines, issue subpoenas, and investigate violations that are specified in the bill.

The Emergency Medical Services Board indicates there would be additional revenues generated by the fines established in the bill; however, the Board cannot estimate how much additional revenue the fines would generate, as the agency is unable to estimate how many violations would occur. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 320 is not reflected in *The FY 2015 Governor's Budget Report*.
