| 5 | Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: |
| 6 | Section 1. K.S.A. 8-260 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-260. |
| 7 | (a) It shall be unlawful for any person, for any purpose, to: |
| 8 | (1) Display or cause or permit to be displayed or have in possession |
| 9 | any fictitious or fraudulently altered driver's license. |
| 10 | (2) Lend any driver's license to any other person or knowingly permit |
| 11 | the use thereof by another. |
| 12 | (3) Display or represent as the person's own, any driver's license not |
| 13 | issued to the person. |
| 14 | (4) Fail or refuse to surrender to the division upon its lawful demand |
| 15 | any driver's license which has been suspended, revoked, or canceled. |
| 16 | (5) Use a false or fictitious name in any application for a driver's |
| 17 | license, or any renewal or replacement thereof, or knowingly conceal a |
| 18 | material fact, or otherwise commit a fraud in any such application. |
| 19 | (6) Permit any unlawful use of a driver's license issued to the person. |
| 20 | (7) Photograph, photostat, duplicate or in any way reproduce any |
| 21 | driver's license or facsimile thereof in such a manner that it could be |
| 22 | mistaken for a valid driver's license or display or have in possession any |
| 23 | such photograph, photostat, duplicate, reproduction or facsimile unless |
| 24 | authorized by law. |
| 25 | (8) Display or possess any photograph, photostat, duplicate or |
| 26 | facsimile of a driver's license unless authorized by law. |
| 27 | (9) Display or cause or permit to be displayed any canceled, revoked |
| 28 | or suspended driver's license. |
| 29 | (b) Violation of paragraphs (1) or paragraph (9) of subsection (a) is |
| 30 | a class B nonperson misdemeanor. Violation of paragraphs (2), (3), (4), |
| 31 | (6), (7) or (8) of subsection (a) is a class A nonperson misdemeanor. |
| 32 | Violation of paragraph (1) of subsection (a) is a class A nonperson with a subsection of paragraph (1) of subsection (2) Violation of paragraph |

9 (4) Display or cause to be displayed or have in possession any 10 fictitious or fraudulently altered driver's license by any person under 21 11 years of age for use in the purchase of any alcoholic liquor or cereal malt 12 beverage.

(d) (1) (A) Upon a first conviction of a violation of any provision
paragraphs (1), (2) or (3) of subsection (c), a person shall be guilty of a
class B nonperson misdemeanor and shall be sentenced to not less than
100 hours of public service and fined not less than \$200 nor more than
\$500.

(B) Upon a first conviction of a violation of paragraph (4) of
subsection (c), a person shall be guilty of a class A nonperson
misdemeanor and fined not less than \$350.

(2) On a second or subsequent conviction of a violation of any
 provision of subsection (c), a person shall be guilty of a class A nonperson
 misdemeanor.

(e) The provisions of this section shall apply to any driver's license,
 nondriver's identification card or other form of identification whether
 issued under the laws of this state or issued under the laws of another state
 or jurisdiction.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 8-1327 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-1327.
(a) It shall be unlawful for any person, for any purpose, to:

(1) Display, cause or permit to be displayed, or have in possession,
 any fictitious, fraudulently altered or fraudulently obtained identification
 card.

(2) Lend any identification card to any other person or knowinglypermit the use thereof by another.

35 (3) Display or represent any identification card not issued to the36 person as being the person's card.

37 (4) Permit any unlawful use of an identification card issued to the 38 person.

(5) Use a false or fictitious name in any application for an
identification card, or any renewal or replacement thereof, or knowingly
conceal a material fact or otherwise commit a fraud in any such
application.

43 (6) Display or possess any photograph, photostat, duplicate,

reproduction or facsimile of an identification card unless authorized by the
 provisions of this act.

3 (7) Photograph, photostat, duplicate or in any way reproduce any 4 identification card or facsimile thereof in such a manner that it could be 5 mistaken for a valid identification card or display or have in possession 6 any such photograph, photostat, duplicate, reproduction or facsimile unless 7 authorized by law.

8 (8) Fail or refuse to surrender to the division upon its lawful demand 9 any identification card which has been canceled.

10 (9) Display or cause or permit to be displayed any canceled 11 identification card.

(b) Violation of paragraphs (1) or paragraph (9) of subsection (a) is
a class B nonperson misdemeanor. Violation of paragraphs (2), (3), (4),
(6), (7) or (8) of subsection (a) is a class A nonperson misdemeanor.
Violation of paragraph (1) of subsection (a) is a class A nonperson
misdemeanor, for which the minimum fine is \$350. Violation of paragraph
(5) of subsection (a) is a severity level 9, nonperson felony.

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(c) It shall be unlawful for any person to:

(1) Lend any identification card to or knowingly permit the use of any
 identification card by any person under 21 years of age for use in the
 purchase of any alcoholic liquor.

(2) Lend any identification card to or knowingly permit the use of any
 identification card by any person under the legal age for consumption of
 cereal malt beverage for use in the purchase of any cereal malt beverage.

(3) Lend any identification card, driver's license or other form of
 identification to aid another person in obtaining an identification card or
 replacement identification card.

(4) Display or cause to be displayed or have in possession any
fictitious or fraudulently altered identification card by any person under 21
years of age for use in the purchase of any alcoholic liquor or cereal malt
beverage.

(d) (1) (A) Upon a first conviction of a violation of any provision *paragraphs (1), (2) or (3)* of subsection (c), a person shall be guilty of a
class B nonperson misdemeanor and shall be sentenced to not less than
100 hours of public service and fined not less than \$200 nor more than
\$500.

(B) Upon a first conviction of a violation of paragraph (4) of
subsection (c), a person shall be guilty of a class A nonperson
misdemeanor and fined not less than \$350.

40 (2) On a second or subsequent conviction of a violation of any
41 provision of subsection (c), a person shall be guilty of a class A nonperson
42 misdemeanor.

43 (e) The provisions of this section shall apply to any identification
