9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
10	Section 1. (a) For the fiscal years ending June 30, 2013, June 30,
11	2014, and June 30, 2015, appropriations are hereby made, restrictions and
12	limitations are hereby imposed, and transfers, capital improvement
13	projects, fees, receipts, disbursements and acts incidental to the foregoing
14	are hereby directed or authorized as provided in this act.
15	(b) The agencies named in this act are hereby authorized to initiate
16	and complete the capital improvement projects specified and authorized by
17	this act or for which appropriations are made by this act, subject to the
18	restrictions and limitations imposed by this act.
19	(c) This act shall not be subject to the provisions of subsection (a) of
20	K.S.A. 75-6702, and amendments thereto.
21	(d) The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to the
22	provisions of K.S.A. 46-155, and amendments thereto.

(a) The university of Kansas is hereby authorized to 24 initiate and complete a capital improvement project for the university of Kansas school of engineering expansion project phase II and such capital 25 26 improvement project is hereby approved for the university of Kansas for 27 the purposes of subsection (b) of K.S.A. 74-8905, and amendments thereto, and the authorization of the issuance of bonds by the Kansas 28 29 development finance authority in accordance with that statute. The 30 university of Kansas may make expenditures from the moneys received 31 from the issuance of any such bonds for such capital improvement project, 32 except that expenditures from the moneys received from the issuance of 33 any such bonds for such capital improvement project shall not exceed 34 \$65,000,000, plus all amounts required for costs of bond issuance, costs of 35 interest on the bonds issued for such capital improvement project during 36 the construction of such project and any required reserves for the payment of principal and interest on the bonds. All moneys received from the 37 38 issuance of any such bonds shall be deposited and accounted for as 39 prescribed by applicable bond covenants. Debt service for any such bonds for such capital improvement project shall be financed by appropriations 40 from any appropriate special revenue fund or funds of the university of 41

42 Kansas.

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(b) During the fiscal years ending June 30, 2014, and June 30, 2015,

1 in addition to the provisions of subsection (a), the university of Kansas is

2 hereby authorized to initiate and complete a capital improvement project

3 for the university of Kansas school of engineering expansion project phase 4 II and such capital improvement project is hereby approved for the

5 university of Kansas for the purposes of subsection (b) of K.S.A. 74-8905,

6 and amendments thereto, and the authorization of the issuance of bonds by

7 the Kansas development finance authority in accordance with that statute.
8 The university of Kansas may make expenditures from the moneys received

9 from the issuance of any such bonds for such capital improvement project, except that expenditures from the moneys received from the issuance of 10 any such bonds for such capital improvement project shall not exceed 11 12 \$15,000,000, plus all amounts required for costs of bond issuance, costs of interest on the bonds issued for such capital improvement project during 13 14 the construction of such project and any required reserves for the payment 15 of principal and interest on the bonds. All moneys received from the 16 issuance of any such bonds shall be deposited and accounted for as 17 prescribed by applicable bond covenants. Debt service for any such bonds for such capital improvement project shall be financed by appropriations 18 19 from any appropriate special revenue fund or funds of the university of 20 Kansas.

21 (c) The university of Kansas shall provide for the annual 22 maintenance and operation costs for such school expansion.
