AN ACT concerning the state board of regents; relating to state
educational institutions; pertaining to the purchase of certain insurance;
amending K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 75-4101 and repealing the existing
section.

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Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

7 K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 75-4101 is hereby amended to read as Section 1. 8 follows: 75-4101. (a) There is hereby created a committee on surety bonds and insurance, which shall consist of the state treasurer, the attorney 9 general and the commissioner of insurance or their respective designees. 10 The commissioner of insurance shall be the chairperson of the committee 11 12 and the director of purchases or the director's designee shall be ex officio 13 secretary. The committee shall meet on call of the chairperson and at such 14 other times as the committee shall determine but at least once each month 15 on the second Monday in each month. Meetings shall be held in the office 16 of the commissioner of insurance. The members of the committee shall 17 serve without compensation. The secretary shall be the custodian of all 18 property, records and proceedings of the committee. Except as provided in 19 this section and K.S.A. 74-4925, 74-4927, 75-6501 through 75-6511 and 20 K.S.A. 76-749, and amendments thereto, no state agency shall purchase 21 any insurance of any kind or nature or any surety bonds upon state officers 22 or employees, except as provided in this act. Except as otherwise provided 23 in this section, health care coverage and health care services of a health 24 maintenance organization for state officers and employees designated 25 under subsection (c) of K.S.A. 75-6501, and amendments thereto, shall be 26 provided in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-6501 through 75-27 6511, and amendments thereto.

28 (b) The Kansas turnpike authority may purchase group life, health 29 and accident insurance or health care services of a health maintenance 30 organization for its employees or members of the highway patrol assigned, 31 by contract or agreement entered pursuant to K.S.A. 68-2025, and 32 amendments thereto, to police toll or turnpike facilities, independent of the 33 committee on surety bonds and insurance and of the provisions of K.S.A. 34 75-6501 through 75-6511, and amendments thereto. Such authority may 35 purchase liability insurance covering all or any part of its operations and may purchase liability and related insurance upon all vehicles owned or 36

operated by the authority independent of the committee on surety bonds 1 2 and insurance and such insurance may be purchased without complying 3 with K.S.A. 75-3738 through 75-3744, and amendments thereto. Any 4 board of county commissioners may purchase such insurance or health 5 care services, independent of such committee, for district court officers 6 and employees any part of whose total salary is payable by the county. 7 Nothing in any other provision of the laws of this state shall be construed 8 as prohibiting members of the highway patrol so assigned to police toll or 9 turnpike facilities from receiving compensation in the form of insurance or health maintenance organization coverage as herein authorized. 10

(c) The agencies of the state sponsoring a foster grandparent or senior 11 companion program, or both, shall procure a policy of accident, personal 12 liability and excess automobile liability insurance insuring volunteers 13 participating in such programs against loss in accordance with 14 specifications of federal grant guidelines. Such agencies may purchase 15 16 such policy of insurance independent of the committee on surety bonds 17 and insurance and without complying with K.S.A. 75-3738 through 75-3744, and amendments thereto. 18

(d) Any postsecondary state educational institution as defined by 19 K.S.A. 74-3201b 76-711, and amendments thereto, may purchase 20 21 insurance of any kind or nature except employee health insurance. Such 22 insurance shall be purchased on a competitively bid or competitively 23 negotiated basis in accordance with procedures prescribed by the state 24 board of regents. Such insurance may be purchased independent of the 25 committee on surety bonds and insurance and without complying with K.S.A. 75-3738 through 75-3744, and amendments thereto. Such-26 27 insurance shall be purchased from an insurance company authorized to-28 transact business in the state of Kansas.

(e) The state board of regents may enter into one or more group 29 insurance contracts to provide health and accident insurance coverage or 30 31 health care services of a health maintenance organization for all students 32 attending a state educational institution as defined in K.S.A. 76-711, and 33 amendments thereto, and such students' dependents, except that such 34 insurance shall not provide coverage for elective procedures that are not 35 medically necessary as determined by a treating physician. The 36 participation by a student in such coverage shall be voluntary. In the case 37 of students who are employed by a state educational institution in a student 38 position, the level of employer contributions toward such coverage shall be 39 determined by the board of regents. The board of regents may adopt rules 40 and regulations necessary to administer and implement the provisions of 41 this section

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2013 Supp. 75-4101 is hereby repealed.
