AN ACT concerning school districts; relating to school finance; relating to contributions to the Kansas public employees retirement system.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. In any action challenging the adequacy of the state's provision for finance of the educational interests of the state, all moneys appropriated, distributed or otherwise provided by the state for employer contributions for school districts to the Kansas public employees retirement system pursuant to K.S.A. 74-4939a, and amendments thereto, shall be deemed by the court to be state aid to school districts for purposes of determining the aggregate amount of state aid appropriated, distributed or otherwise provided by the state to public schools to finance the educational interests of the state.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
