Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 25-4153b is hereby amended to read as follows: 25-4153b. (a) No political committee, a major purpose of which is to expressly advocate the nomination, election or defeat of a clearly identified candidate for the legislature or to make contributions or expenditures for the nomination, election or defeat of a clearly identified candidate for the legislature, shall be established by a member of the legislature.

- (b) Any such political committee existing prior to the effective date of this act is hereby abolished. Any funds remaining in the possession of such political committee may be donated in its entirety to a political party.
- Sec. 2. K.S.A. 25-4153b is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
