1	AN ACT concerning crimes, criminal procedure and punishment; relating
2	to unlawful possession of prescription drugs; amending K.S.A. 2012
3	Supp. 21-5708 and repealing the existing section.
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5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
6	Section 1. K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 21-5708 is hereby amended to read as
7	follows: 21-5708. (a) Unlawfully obtaining or possessing a prescription-
8	only drug is:
9	(1) Making, altering or signing of a prescription order by a person
10	other than a practitioner or a mid-level practitioner;
11	(2) distribution of distributing a prescription order, knowing it to have
12	been made, altered or signed by a person other than a practitioner or a mid-
13	level practitioner;
14	(3) possession of possessing a prescription order with intent to
15	distribute it and knowing it to have been made, altered or signed by a
16	person other than a practitioner or a mid-level practitioner;
17	(4) possession of possessing a prescription-only drug knowing it to
18	have been obtained pursuant to a prescription order made, altered or
19	signed by a person other than a practitioner or a mid-level practitioner; or
20	(5) providing false information, with the intent to deceive, to a
21	practitioner or mid-level practitioner for the purpose of obtaining a
22	prescription-only drug.; or
23	(6) knowingly possessing a prescription-only drug by a person other
24	than the holder of a valid prescription order.
25	(b) Unlawfully selling a prescription-only drug is unlawfully
26	obtaining or possessing a prescription-only drug, as defined in subsection
27	(a), and:
28	(1) Selling the prescription-only drug <del>so obtained</del> ;
29	(2) offering for sale the prescription-only drug <del>so obtained</del> ; or
30	(3) possessing with intent to sell the prescription-only drug so-
31	obtained.
32	(c) (1) Unlawfully obtaining <i>or possessing</i> a prescription-only drug is
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34	(A) Class A nonperson misdemeanor, except as provided in
35	subsection (c)(1)(B); and (D) $= 10^{-1}$ (c)(1)(B); and (D)
36	(B) nondrug severity level 9, nonperson felony if that person has a

prior conviction of under this section, K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 21-36a08, prior 1 to its transfer, or K.S.A. 21-4214, prior to its repeal. 2

(2) Unlawfully selling a prescription-only drug is a nondrug severity 3 4 level 6, nonperson felony.

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(d) As used in this section:

6 (1) "Holder of a valid prescription order" means: (A) A person to 7 whom a valid prescription order is issued for the purpose of obtaining a prescription-only drug; and (B) such holder's implicitly or explicitly 8 authorized agent for the purpose of facilitating delivery of such 9 prescription-only drug to such holder. 10

(1)(2) "Pharmacist," "practitioner," "mid-level practitioner" and 11 12 "prescription-only drug" shall have the same meanings ascribed thereto by as defined in K.S.A. 65-1626, and amendments thereto. 13

(2)(3) "Prescription order" means an order transmitted in writing, 14 15 orally, telephonically or by other means of communication for a 16 prescription-only drug to be filled by a pharmacist. "Prescription order" does not mean a drug dispensed pursuant to such an order. 17

(e) The provisions of this section shall not be applicable to 18 19 prosecutions involving prescription-only drugs which could be brought 20 under K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 21-5705 or 21-5706, and amendments thereto. 21

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 21-5708 is hereby repealed.

22 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 23 publication in the statute book.

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
