1	AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to definitions; updating
2	terms concerning titling and registration; amending K.S.A. 40-298 and
3	59-3508 and K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 8-126 and 44-1204 and repealing the
4	existing sections.
5	
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
7	Section 1. K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 8-126 is hereby amended to read as
8	follows: 8-126. The following words and phrases when used in this act
9	shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them herein:
10	(a) "Vehiele" means every device in, upon or by which any person or
11	property is or may be transported or drawn upon a public highway,-
12	excepting electric personal assistive mobility devices or devices moved by
13	human power or used exclusively upon stationary rails or tracks.
14	(b) "Motor vehicle" means every vehicle, other than a motorized-
15	bicycle or a motorized wheelchair, which is self-propelled.
16	(c) "Truck" means a motor vehicle which is used for the-
17	transportation or delivery of freight and merchandise or more than 10-
18	passengers.
19	(d) "Motorcycle" means every motor vehicle designed to travel on not
20	more than three wheels in contact with the ground, except any such vehicle
21	as may be included within the term "tractor" as herein defined.
22	(c) "Truck tractor" means every motor vehicle designed and used-
23	primarily for drawing other vehicles, and not so constructed as to carry a
24	load other than a part of the weight of the vehicle or load so drawn.
25	(f) "Farm tractor" means every motor vehicle designed and used as a
26	farm implement power unit operated with or without other attached farm
27	implements in any manner consistent with the structural design of such
28	<del>power unit.</del>
29	(g) "Road tractor" means every motor vehicle designed and used for
30	drawing other vehicles, and not so constructed as to carry any load thereon
31	independently, or any part of the weight of a vehicle or load so drawn.
32	(h) "Trailer" means every vehicle without motive power designed to
33	carry property or passengers wholly on its own structure and to be drawn
34	by a motor vehicle.
35	(i) "Semitrailer" means every vehicle of the trailer type so designed
36	and used in conjunction with a motor vehicle that some part of its own-

1 weight and that of its own load rests upon or is carried by another vehicle.

2 (j) "Pole trailer" means any two-wheel vehicle used as a trailer with
 3 bolsters that support the load, and do not have a rack or body extending to
 4 the tractor drawing the load.

5 (k) "Specially constructed vehicle" means any vehicle which shall not 6 have been originally constructed under a distinctive name, make, model or 7 type, or which, if originally otherwise constructed shall have been-8 materially altered by the removal of essential parts, or by the addition or 9 substitution of essential parts, new or used, derived from other vehicles or 10 makes of vehicles.

(1) "Foreign vehicle" means every motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer
 which shall be brought into this state otherwise than in ordinary course of
 business by or through a manufacturer or dealer and which has not been
 registered in this state.

(m) "Person" means every natural person, firm, partnership,
 association or corporation.

17 (n) "Owner" means a person who holds the legal title of a vehicle, or 18 in the event a vehicle is the subject of an agreement for the conditional-19 sale thereof with the right of purchase upon performance of the conditions 20 stated in the agreement and with an immediate right of possession vested 21 in the conditional vendee or in the event a vehicle is subject to a lease of 22 30 days or more with an immediate right of possession vested in the 23 lessee; or in the event a party having a security interest in a vehicle is 24 entitled to possession, then such conditional vendee or lessee or secured 25 party shall be deemed the owner for the purpose of this act.

26 (o) "Nonresident" means every person who is not a resident of this 27 state.

(p) "Manufacturer" means every person engaged in the business of
 manufacturing motor vehicles, trailers or semitrailers.

(q) "New vehicle dealer" means every person actively engaged in the
 business of buying, selling or exchanging new motor vehicles, travel trailers, trailers or vehicles and who holds a dealer's contract therefor from
 a manufacturer or distributor and who has an established place of business
 in this state.

(r) "Used vehicle dealer" means every person actively engaged in the
 business of buying, selling or exchanging used vehicles, and having an
 established place of business in this state and who does not hold a dealer's
 contract for the sale of new motor vehicles, travel trailers, trailers or
 vehicles.

40 (s) "Highway" means every way or place of whatever nature open to
 41 the use of the public as a matter of right for the purpose of vehicular travel.
 42 The term "highway" shall not be deemed to include a roadway or driveway
 43 upon grounds owned by private owners, colleges, universities or other-

1 institutions. 2 (t) "Department" or "motor vehicle department" or "vehicle-3 department" means the division of vehicles of the department of revenue, 4 acting directly or through its duly authorized officers and agents. When 5 acting on behalf of the department of revenue pursuant to this act, a county 6 treasurer shall be deemed to be an agent of the state of Kansas. 7 (u) "Commission" or "state highway commission" means the director 8 of vehicles of the department of revenue. 9 (v) "Division" means the division of vehicles of the department of 10 revenue. 11 (w) "Travel trailer" means every vehicle without motive powerdesigned to be towed by a motor vehicle constructed primarily for-12 13 recreational purposes. (x) "Passenger vehicle" means every motor vehicle, as herein defined, 14 which is designed primarily to carry 10 or fewer passengers, and which is 15 16 not used as a truck. 17 (y) "Self-propelled farm implement" means every farm implementdesigned for specific use applications with its motive power unit-18 19 permanently incorporated in its structural design. 20 (z) "Farm trailer" means every trailer as defined in subsection (h) of 21 this section and every semitrailer as defined in subsection (i) of this-22 section, designed and used primarily as a farm vehicle. 23 (aa) "Motorized bieyele" means every device having two tandemwheels or three wheels, which may be propelled by either human power or 24 25 helper motor, or by both, and which has: 26 (1) A motor which produces not more than 3.5 brake horsepower; 27 (2) a cylinder capacity of not more than 130 cubic centimeters; 28 (3) an automatic transmission; and 29 (4) the capability of a maximum design speed of no more than 30-30 miles per hour. 31 (bb) "All-terrain vehicle" means any motorized nonhighway vehicle 50 inches or less in width, having a dry weight of 1,500 pounds or less, 32 33 traveling on three or more nonhighway tires, having a seat designed to be 34 straddled by the operator. As used in this subsection, nonhighway tire-35 means any pneumatic tire six inches or more in width, designed for use on 36 wheels with rim diameter of 14 inches or less. 37 (ce) "Implement of husbandry" means every vehicle designed or-38 adapted and used exclusively for agricultural operations, including-39 feedlots, and only incidentally moved or operated upon the highways.-40 Such term shall include, but not be limited to: 41 (1) A farm tractor; (2) a self-propelled farm implement; 42 43 (3) a fertilizer spreader, nurse tank or truck permanently mounted

1 with a spreader used exclusively for dispensing or spreading water, dust or

2 liquid fertilizers or agricultural chemicals, as defined in K.S.A. 2-2202,
 3 and amendments thereto, regardless of ownership;

4 (4) a truck mounted with a fertilizer spreader used or manufactured 5 principally to spread animal dung;

6 (5) a mixer-feed truck owned and used by a feedlot, as defined in
 7 K.S.A. 47-1501, and amendments thereto, and specially designed and used
 8 exclusively for dispensing food to livestock in such feedlot.

9 (dd) "Motorized wheelchair" means any self-propelled vehicle-10 designed specifically for use by a physically disabled person that is-11 incapable of a speed in excess of 15 miles per hour.

12 (ee) "Oil well servicing, oil well clean-out or oil well drilling-13 machinery or equipment" means a vehicle constructed as a machine used exclusively for servicing, cleaning-out or drilling an oil well and 14 15 consisting in general of a mast, an engine for power, a draw works and a 16 ehassis permanently constructed or assembled for one or more of those 17 purposes. The passenger capacity of the cab of a vehicle shall not be 18 considered in determining whether such vehicle is an oil well servicing, oil well clean-out or oil well drilling machinery or equipment. 19

(ff) "Electric personal assistive mobility device" means a self balancing two nontandem wheeled device, designed to transport only one
 person, with an electric propulsion system that limits the maximum speed
 of the device to 15 miles per hour or less.

(gg) "Electronic certificate of title" means any electronic record of
 ownership, including any lien or liens that may be recorded, retained by
 the division in accordance with K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 8-135d, and
 amendments thereto.

28 (hh) "Work-site utility vehicle" means any motor vehicle which is not 29 less than 48 inches in width, has an overall length, including the bumper, 30 of not more than 135 inches, has an unladen weight, including fuel and 31 fluids, of more than 800 pounds and is equipped with four or more low 32 pressure tires, a steering wheel and bench or bucket-type seating allowing 33 at least two people to sit side-by-side, and may be equipped with a bed or 34 eargo box for hauling materials. "Work-site utility vehicle" does not 35 include a micro utility truck or recreational off-highway vehicle.

(ii) "Micro utility truck" means any motor vehicle which is not less
than 48 inches in width, has an overall length, including the bumper, of not
more than 160 inches, has an unladen weight, including fuel and fluids, of
more than 1,500 pounds, can exceed 40 miles per hour as originallymanufactured and is manufactured with a metal cab. "Micro utility truck"
does not include a work-site utility vehicle or recreational off-highwayvehicle.

(jj) "Golf cart" means a motor vehicle that has not less than three-

1 wheels in contact with the ground, an unladen weight of not more than

2 1,800 pounds, is designed to be and is operated at not more than 25 miles

3 per hour and is designed to carry not more than four persons including the
 4 driver.

(kk) "Recreational off-highway vehicle" means any motor vehicle 64
inches or less in width, having a dry weight of 2,000 pounds or less,
traveling on four or more nonhighway tires, having a nonstraddle seat and
steering wheel for steering control.

9 (11) "Lightweight roadable vehicle" means a multipurpose motor-10 vehicle that is allowed to be driven on public roadways and is required to 11 be registered with, and flown under the direction of, the federal aviation 12 administration.

(a) "All-terrain vehicle" means any motorized nonhighway vehicle 50
inches or less in width, having a dry weight of 1,500 pounds or less,
traveling on three or more nonhighway tires, having a seat designed to be
straddled by the operator. As used in this subsection, "nonhighway tire"
means any pneumatic tire six inches or more in width, designed for use on
wheels with rim diameter of 14 inches or less.

(b) "Bus" means every motor vehicle designed for carrying more than
10 passengers and used for the transportation of persons; and every motor
vehicle, other than a taxicab, designed and used for the transportation of
persons for compensation.

(c) "Commission" or "state highway commission" means the director
 of vehicles of the department of revenue.

(d) "Department" or "motor vehicle department" or "vehicle
department" means the division of vehicles of the department of revenue,
acting directly or through its duly authorized officers and agents. When
acting on behalf of the department of revenue pursuant to this act, a
county treasurer shall be deemed to be an agent of the state of Kansas.

30 *(e)* "Division" means the division of vehicles of the department of 31 revenue.

(f) "Electric-assisted bicycle" means a bicycle with two or three wheels, a saddle, fully operative pedals for human propulsion, and an electric motor. The electric-assisted bicycle's electric motor must have a power output of no more than 1,000 watts, be incapable of propelling the device at a speed of more than 20 miles per hour on level ground and incapable of further increasing the speed of the device when human power alone is used to propel the device beyond 20 miles per hour.

(g) "Electric personal assistive mobility device" means a selfbalancing two nontandem wheeled device, designed to transport only one
person, with an electric propulsion system that limits the maximum speed
of the device to 15 miles per hour or less.

43 (h) "Electric vehicle" means a vehicle that is powered by an electric

1 motor drawing current from rechargeable storage batteries or other 2 portable electrical energy storage devices, provided the recharge energy

must be drawn from a source off the vehicle, such as, but not limited to: 3 4

(1) Residential electric service;

5 (2) electric vehicle charging station, also called EV charging station, 6 electric recharging point, charging point, EVSE (Electric Vehicle Supply 7 Equipment) or public charging station.

8 (i) "Electronic certificate of title" means any electronic record of 9 ownership, including any lien or liens that may be recorded, retained by the division in accordance with K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 8-135d, and 10 amendments thereto 11

12 "Electronic Notice of Security Interest" means the division's online (i) internet program which enables a dealer or secured party to submit a 13 notice of security interest defined in subsection (jj) and to cancel the 14 15 notice or release the security interest using the program. This program is 16 also known as the Kansas elien or KSelien.

17 "Essential parts" means all integral and body parts of a vehicle of (k) 18 a type required to be registered hereunder, the removal, alteration or 19 substitution of which would tend to conceal the identity of the vehicle or 20 substantially alter its appearance, model, type or mode of operation.

21 "Farm tractor" means every motor vehicle designed and used as a (l)22 farm implement power unit operated with or without other attached farm 23 implements in any manner consistent with the structural design of such 24 power unit.

25 (m) "Farm trailer" means every trailer as defined in subsection (h) of this section and every semitrailer as defined in subsection (i) of this 26 section, designed and used primarily as a farm vehicle. 27

28 (n) "Foreign vehicle" means every motor vehicle, trailer or 29 semitrailer which shall be brought into this state otherwise than in ordinary course of business by or through a manufacturer or dealer and 30 31 which has not been registered in this state.

(o) "Golf cart" means a motor vehicle that has not less than three 32 33 wheels in contact with the ground, an unladen weight of not more than 34 1,800 pounds, is designed to be and is operated at not more than 25 miles 35 per hour and is designed to carry not more than four persons including the 36 driver

37 "Gross weight" means the weight of a vehicle without load plus (p)38 the weight of any load thereon.

39 "Highway" means every way or place of whatever nature open to (a)the use of the public as a matter of right for the purpose of vehicular 40 travel. The term "highway" shall not be deemed to include a roadway or 41 driveway upon grounds owned by private owners, colleges, universities or 42 43 other institutions.

"House trailer" means: 1 (r)(1)

2 (A) A trailer or semitrailer which is designed, constructed and equipped as a dwelling place, living abode or sleeping place, either 3 4 permanently or temporarily, and is equipped for use as a conveyance on 5 streets and highways; or

6 (B) a trailer or a semitrailer whose chassis and exterior shell is 7 designed and constructed for use as a house trailer, as defined in this subsection, but which is used instead permanently or temporarily for the 8 advertising, sales, display or promotion of merchandise or services, or for 9 any other commercial purpose except the transportation of property for 10 *hire or the transportation of property for distribution by a private carrier.* 11

12 (2) "House trailer" does not include a manufactured home or a mobile home, as such terms are defined in K.S.A. 58-4202, and 13 amendments thereto 14

"Identifying numbers" means the numbers, and letters, if any, on a 15 *(s)* 16 vehicle designated by the division for the purpose of identifying the 17 vehicle

"Implement of husbandry" means every vehicle designed or 18 (t)19 adapted and used exclusively for agricultural operations, including feedlots, and only incidentally moved or operated upon the highways. 20 21 Such term shall include. but not be limited to:

22 (1) A farm tractor:

23

(2) a self-propelled farm implement;

(3) a fertilizer spreader, nurse tank or truck permanently mounted 24 25 with a spreader used exclusively for dispensing or spreading water, dust or liquid fertilizers or agricultural chemicals, as defined in K.S.A. 2-2202, 26 and amendments thereto, regardless of ownership; 27

28 (4) a truck mounted with a fertilizer spreader used or manufactured 29 principally to spread animal dung;

(5) a mixer-feed truck owned and used by a feedlot, as defined in 30 31 K.S.A. 47-1501, and amendments thereto, and specially designed and used 32 exclusively for dispensing food to livestock in such feedlot.

33

"Lien" means a security interest defined in subsection (ww).

"Lienholder" means a person holding a security interest in a 34 (v)35 vehicle

36 "Lightweight roadable vehicle" means a multipurpose motor (w)37 vehicle that is allowed to be driven on public roadways and is required to 38 be registered with, and flown under the direction of, the federal aviation 39 administration

"Low-speed vehicle" means any four-wheeled electric vehicle 40 (x)whose top speed is greater than 20 miles per hour but not greater than 25 41 miles per hour and is manufactured in compliance with the national 42 43 highway and traffic safety administration standards for low speed vehicles

2 (y) "Mail" means to deposit in the United States mail properly 3 addressed and with postage prepaid.

4 (z) "Manufacturer" means every person engaged in the business of 5 manufacturing motor vehicles, trailers or semitrailers.

6 (aa) "Micro utility truck" means any motor vehicle which is not less 7 than 48 inches in width, has an overall length, including the bumper, of 8 not more than 160 inches, has an unladen weight, including fuel and 9 fluids, of more than 1,500 pounds, can exceed 40 miles per hour as 10 originally manufactured and is manufactured with a metal cab. "Micro 11 utility truck" does not include a work-site utility vehicle or recreational 12 off-highway vehicle.

(bb) "Motor-driven cycle" means every motorcycle, including every
motor scooter, with a motor which produces not to exceed five brake
horsepower, and every bicycle with motor attached, except a motorized
bicycle or an electric-assisted bicycle.

(cc) "Motor home" means every motor vehicle designed, used or
 maintained primarily as a mobile dwelling, office or commercial space.

(dd) "Motor vehicle" means every vehicle, other than a motorized
bicycle or a motorized wheelchair, which is self-propelled.

(ee) "Motorcycle" means every motor vehicle designed to travel on
not more than three wheels in contact with the ground, except any such
vehicle as may be included within the term "tractor" as herein defined.

(ff) "Motorized bicycle" means every device having two tandem
wheels or three wheels, which may be propelled by either human power or
helper motor, or by both, and which has:

(1) A motor which produces not more than 3.5 brake horsepower;

28 (2) a cylinder capacity of not more than 130 cubic centimeters;

29 *(3) an automatic transmission; and* 

30 *(4) the capability of a maximum design speed of no more than 30* 31 *miles per hour.* 

32 (gg) "Motorized wheelchair" means any self-propelled vehicle 33 designed specifically for use by a physically disabled person that is 34 incapable of a speed in excess of 15 miles per hour.

(hh) "New vehicle dealer" means every person actively engaged in
the business of buying, selling or exchanging new motor vehicles, travel
trailers, trailers or vehicles and who holds a dealer's contract therefor
from a manufacturer or distributor and who has an established place of
business in this state.

40 *(ii)* "Nonresident" means every person who is not a resident of this 41 state.

42 (jj) "Notice of Security Interest" means a notification to the division 43 from a dealer or secured party of a purchase money security interest as provided in article 9 of chapter 84 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and
 amendments thereto, upon a vehicle which has been sold and delivered to

the purchaser describing the vehicle and showing the name, address and acknowledgement of the secured party as well as the name and address of the debtor(s) and other information the division requires.

6 "Oil well servicing, oil well clean-out or oil well drilling (kk) 7 machinery or equipment" means a vehicle constructed as a machine used 8 exclusively for servicing, cleaning-out or drilling an oil well and consisting in general of a mast, an engine for power, a draw works and a 9 chassis permanently constructed or assembled for one or more of those 10 purposes. The passenger capacity of the cab of a vehicle shall not be 11 12 considered in determining whether such vehicle is oil well servicing, oil well clean-out or oil well drilling machinery or equipment. 13

(11) "Owner" means a person who holds the legal title of a vehicle, or 14 in the event a vehicle is the subject of an agreement for the conditional 15 16 sale thereof with the right of purchase upon performance of the conditions stated in the agreement and with an immediate right of possession vested 17 in the conditional vendee, or in the event a vehicle is subject to a lease of 18 19 30 days or more with an immediate right of possession vested in the lessee; or in the event a party having a security interest in a vehicle is 20 21 entitled to possession, then such conditional vendee or lessee or secured 22 party shall be deemed the owner for the purpose of this act.

(mm) "Passenger car" means every motor vehicle, except
 motorcycles and motor-driven cycles, designed for carrying 10 passengers
 or less and used for the transportation of persons.

26 (nn) "Passenger vehicle" means every motor vehicle, as herein 27 defined, which is designed primarily to carry 10 or fewer passengers, and 28 which is not used as a truck.

29 (oo) "Person" means every natural person, firm, partnership,
 30 association or corporation.

(pp) "Pneumatic tire" means every tire in which compressed air is
 designed to support the load.

(qq) "Pole trailer" means any two-wheel vehicle used as a trailer
with bolsters that support the load, and do not have a rack or body
extending to the tractor drawing the load.

(rr) "Recreational off-highway vehicle" means any motor vehicle 64
inches or less in width, having a dry weight of 2,000 pounds or less,
traveling on four or more nonhighway tires, having a nonstraddle seat and
steering wheel for steering control.

40 (ss) "Registration" means the registration certificate or certificates 41 and registration plates issued under the laws of this state pertaining to the 42 registration of vehicles.

43 (tt) "Road tractor" means every motor vehicle designed and used for

drawing other vehicles, and not so constructed as to carry any load
 thereon independently, or any part of the weight of a vehicle or load so
 drawn.

4 *(uu)* "School bus" means every motor vehicle defined and designated 5 as a school bus in subsection (g)(1) of K.S.A. 72-8301, and amendments 6 thereto.

7 (vv) "Security agreement" means a written agreement which reserves 8 or creates a security interest.

9 (ww) "Security interest" means an interest in a vehicle reserved or 10 created by agreement and which secures payment or performance of an 11 obligation. The term includes the interest of a lessor under a lease 12 intended as a security. A security interest is "perfected" when it is valid 13 against third parties generally, subject only to specific statutory 14 exceptions.

15 (xx) "Self-propelled farm implement" means every farm implement 16 designed for specific use applications with its motive power unit 17 permanently incorporated in its structural design.

(yy) "Semitrailer" means every vehicle of the trailer type so designed
and used in conjunction with a motor vehicle that some part of its own
weight and that of its own load rests upon or is carried by another vehicle.

(zz) "Solid rubber tire" means every tire of rubber or other resilient
 material which does not depend upon compressed air for the support of
 the load.

(aaa) "Specially constructed vehicle" means any vehicle which shall
not have been originally constructed under a distinctive name, make,
model or type, or which, if originally otherwise constructed shall have
been materially altered by the removal of essential parts, or by the
addition or substitution of essential parts, new or used, derived from other
vehicles or makes of vehicles.

(bbb) "Trailer" means every vehicle without motive power designed
to carry property or passengers wholly on its own structure and to be
drawn by a motor vehicle.

(ccc) "Transporter" means every person engaged in the business of
 delivering vehicles, of a type required to be registered in this state, from a
 manufacturing, assembling or distributing plant to dealers or sales agents
 of a manufacturer.

37 (ddd) "Travel trailer" means every vehicle without motive power
38 designed to be towed by a motor vehicle constructed primarily for
39 recreational purposes.

40 (eee) "Truck" means a motor vehicle which is used for the 41 transportation or delivery of freight and merchandise or more than 10 42 passengers.

43 (fff) "Truck tractor" means every motor vehicle designed and used

primarily for drawing other vehicles, and not so constructed as to carry a
 load other than a part of the weight of the vehicle or load so drawn.

3 (ggg) "Used vehicle dealer" means every person actively engaged in 4 the business of buying, selling or exchanging used vehicles, and having an 5 established place of business in this state and who does not hold a dealer's 6 contract for the sale of new motor vehicles, travel trailers, trailers or 7 vehicles.

8 (hhh) "Vehicle" means every device in, upon or by which any person
9 or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a public highway,
10 excepting electric personal assistive mobility devices or devices moved by
11 human power or used exclusively upon stationary rails or tracks.

12 (iii) "Work-site utility vehicle" means any motor vehicle which is not less than 48 inches in width, has an overall length, including the bumper, 13 of not more than 135 inches, has an unladen weight, including fuel and 14 15 fluids, of more than 800 pounds and is equipped with four or more low 16 pressure tires, a steering wheel and bench or bucket-type seating allowing at least two people to sit side-by-side, and may be equipped with a bed or 17 cargo box for hauling materials. "Work-site utility vehicle" does not 18 19 include a micro utility truck or recreational off-highway vehicle.

20 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 40-298 is hereby amended to read as follows: 40-298. 21 As used in this act, the following words and phrases shall have the 22 meanings respectively ascribed to them herein:

(a) "Automobile dealer" means a dealer as defined by K.S.A. 8-178;

(b) "Automobile" means a passenger vehicle as defined by subsection
 (x) of K.S.A. 8-126, and amendments thereto;

(c) "Dealer" means any automobile dealer or lending agency;

(d) "Lending agency" means any person engaged in the business of
 financing or lending money to any person to be used in the purchase or
 financing of a motor vehicle; and

(e) "Person" means any individual, partnership, corporation or otherassociation of persons.

Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 44-1204 is hereby amended to read as follows: 44-1204. (a) On and after January 1, 1978, no employer shall employ any employee for a workweek longer than forty-six (46) 46 hours, unless such employee receives compensation for employment in excess of forty-six (46) 46 hours in a workweek at a rate of not less than-one and one-half ( $1^{+}/_{2}$ )  $1^{1}/_{2}$  times the hourly wage rate at which such employee is regularly employed.

(b) No employer shall be deemed to have violated subsection (a) with
respect to the employment of any employee who is covered by this section,
who is engaged in the public or private delivery of emergency medical
services as an attendant as defined by K.S.A. 65-6112, and amendments
thereto, or who is engaged in fire protection or law enforcement activities,

1 including any member of the security personnel in any correctional 2 institution, and who is paid compensation at a rate of not less than  $1^{1}/_{2}$ 3 times the regular rate at which such employee is employed:

4 (1) In any work period of 28 consecutive days in which such 5 employee works for tours of duty which in the aggregate exceed 258 6 hours; or

7 (2) in the case of any such employee to whom a work period of at 8 least seven but less than 28 days applies, in any such work period in which 9 such employee works for tours of duty which in the aggregate exceed a 10 number of hours which bears the same ratio to the number of consecutive 11 days in such work period as 258 hours bears to 28 days.

12 (c) The provisions of this section shall not apply to the employment13 of:

(1) Any employee who is covered under the provisions of section 7 of
the fair labor standards act of 1938 as amended (,29 U.S.C.A. § 207), and
as amended by the fair labor standards amendments of 1974, and any other
acts amendatory thereof or supplemental *amendments* thereto; or

(2) any employee who is primarily engaged in selling motor vehicles,
as defined in subsection (b) of K.S.A. 8-126, and amendments thereto, for
a nonmanufacturing employer primarily engaged in the business of selling
such vehicles to ultimate purchasers;

(3) any person who is sentenced to the custody of the secretary ofcorrections and any person serving a sentence in a county jail.

(d) For the purposes of this section, the agreement or practice by
employees engaged in fire protection or law enforcement activities of
substituting for one another on regularly scheduled tours of duty, or a part
thereof, shall be deemed to have no effect on hours of work if:

(1) The substituting is done voluntarily by the employees and not atthe behest of the employer;

(2) the reason for substituting is due not to the employer's businesspractice but to the employee's desire or need to attend to a personal matter;

32 (3) a record is maintained by the employer of all time substituted by33 the employer's employees; and

34 (4) the period during which time is substituted and paid back does not35 exceed 12 months.

Sec. 4. K.S.A. 59-3508 is hereby amended to read as follows: 59-3508. A motor vehicle, as defined by-subsection (b) of K.S.A. 8-126, and amendments thereto, may be titled in transfer-on-death, TOD, form by including in the certificate of title a designation of a beneficiary or beneficiaries to whom the motor vehicle shall be transferred on death of the owner or the last survivor of the joint tenant with right of survivorship owners, subject to the rights of all lien holders.
