Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding any provision of the prison-made goods act of Kansas to the contrary, the secretary shall not establish or maintain a home building program which manufacturers or produces housing units which would compete with the:

- (1) (A) Manufactured homes or modular homes manufactured, assembled or sold by manufactured home manufacturers; or
- (B) manufactured homes or modular homes sold by manufactured home dealers; or
- 13 (2) (A) modular homes manufactured, assembled or sold by modular home manufacturers; or
  - (B) modular homes sold by modular home dealers.
    - (b) As used in this section:
- 17 (1) "Manufactured home" has the meaning ascribed to such term by 18 K.S.A. 58-4202, and amendments thereto;
- 19 (2) "manufactured home dealer" has the meaning ascribed to such 20 term by K.S.A. 58-4202, and amendments thereto;
- 21 (3) "manufactured home manufacturer" has the meaning ascribed to 22 such term by K.S.A. 58-4202, and amendments thereto;
  - (4) "modular home" has the meaning ascribed to such term by K.S.A. 58-4202, and amendments thereto; and
    - (5) "secretary" means the secretary of corrections.
- 26 (c) This section shall be a part of and supplemental to the prison-27 made goods act of Kansas.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
