A PROPOSITION to amend article 15 of the constitution of the state of
 Kansas by adding a new section thereto, authorizing the legislature to
 permit the conduct of charitable raffles by certain nonprofit
 organizations.

6 Be it resolved by the Legislature of the State of Kansas, two-thirds of the

7 members elected (or appointed) and qualified to the Senate and two-

8 thirds of the members elected (or appointed) and qualified to the House

9 of Representatives concurring therein:

Section 1. The following proposition to amend the constitution of the state of Kansas shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the state for their approval or rejection: Article 15 of the constitution of the state of Kansas is hereby amended by adding a new section thereto to read as follows:

"§ 3d. Regulation of "raffles" authorized. Notwithstanding 15 the provisions of section 3 of article 15 of the constitution of the 16 17 state of Kansas, the legislature may authorize the licensing, conduct and regulation of charitable raffles, as defined by law, by 18 nonprofit religious, charitable, fraternal, educational and veterans 19 organizations. A raffle means a game of chance in which each 20 participant buys a ticket or tickets from a nonprofit organization 21 22 with each ticket providing an equal chance to win a prize and the winner being determined by a random drawing. Such organizations 23 shall not use an electronic gaming machine or-slot {vending} 24 25 machine to sell tickets or conduct raffles. No such nonprofit 26 organization shall contract with a professional raffle or other 27 lottery vendor to manage, operate or conduct any raffle. Raffles shall be licensed and regulated by the Kansas department of 28 29 revenue, office of charitable gaming or successor agency."

30 Sec. 2. The following statement shall be printed on the ballot with the 31 amendment as a whole:

- *"Explanatory statement.* The constitution currently prohibits the
 operation of lotteries except for specifically authorized
 lotteries. A raffle is a lottery and is illegal under current law.
- 35 "A vote for this proposition would permit the legislature to36 authorize charitable raffles operated or conducted by

religious, charitable, fraternal, educational and veterans nonprofit organizations subject to the limitations listed. Nonprofit organizations would be prohibited from contracting with a professional lottery vendor to manage, operate or conduct a charitable raffle.

"A vote against this proposition would continue the current prohibition against all raffles."

8 This resolution, if approved by two-thirds of the members Sec. 3. elected (or appointed) and qualified to the Senate, and two-thirds of the 9 members elected (or appointed) and qualified to the House of 10 Representatives shall be entered on the journals, together with the yeas 11 and nays. The secretary of state shall cause this resolution to be published 12 as provided by law and shall cause the proposed amendment to be 13 submitted to the electors of the state at the general election in November 14 in the year 2014 unless a special election is called at a sooner date by 15 concurrent resolution of the legislature, in which case it shall be 16 submitted to the electors of the state at the special election. 17
