## **SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2115**

# As Recommended by House Committee on Judiciary

### **Brief\***

HB 2115 would amend provisions concerning temporary judicial employment of retired judges to remove requirements that a retired judge enter into a written agreement for such employment with the Kansas Supreme Court either before retirement or within 5 years after retirement and within 30 days before the judge's retirement anniversary.

# **Background**

In the House Committee on Judiciary, a representative of the Chief Justice appeared in support of the bill. No others offered testimony.

The Division of the Budget's fiscal note indicates passage of HB 2115 would have no fiscal effect on the Judicial Branch.
