SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2149

As Amended by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

Brief*

HB 2149, as amended, would eliminate a \$500,000 transfer from the Highway Patrol Training Center Fund to the State General Fund that occurs each fiscal year. All monies credited to the Highway Patrol Training Center Fund would remain in the Fund.

Background

The Senate Ways and Means Committee deleted the contents of the bill and inserted the contents of SB 117. SB 117 would eliminate a \$500,000 transfer from the Highway Patrol Training Center Fund to the State General Fund that occurs each fiscal year. All monies credited to the Highway Patrol Training Center Fund would remain in the Fund. (The Senate Committee previously amended the contents of HB 2149 into HB 2142.)

The Kansas Highway Patrol testified that eliminating the transfer in SB 117 would allow the agency to develop a dedicated fund and allow for hiring new troopers.

The fiscal note submitted by the Division of the Budget indicates the impact of SB 117 is included in *The FY 2014 Governor's Budget Report*. However, any additional costs incurred by the Kansas Highway Patrol are not included.
