SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 216

As Recommended by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

Brief*

SB 216 would amend existing law to state a municipal university, as well as any state university, would have the ability to use a public building commission to acquire land and facilities near or adjacent to the university or could acquire by lease, land and facilities constituting a part of the campus of the institution. The bill also would allow the public building commission to acquire the fee simple title to real property, or a leasehold interest in real property, located on the campus of any municipal university.

The bill would be in effect upon publication in the Kansas Register.

Background

Testimony was presented by Dr. Jerry B. Farley, President of Washburn University, as a proponent of the bill. There was no other testimony.

The Committee recommended the bill be placed on the consent calendar.

The Division of the Budget fiscal note stated enactment of the bill would have no fiscal effect.
