

HOUSE BILL No. 2721

1 AN ACT concerning Kansas government, relating to boards, commissions,
2 councils, authorities and other governmental entities; creating
3 committees to study shared resources, labor capacities and mission
4 alignment.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. (a) There is hereby created the general industry regulatory
7 committee, the public health and welfare regulatory committee and the
8 financial industry regulatory committee. The purpose of these committees
9 is to study strategic shared resources, consolidated leadership and
10 budgetary oversight of the entities listed in subsections (1), (2), (3), (4), (5), (6), (7), (8), (9), (10), (11), (12), (13), (14), (15), (16), (17), (18), (19), (20), (21), (22), (23), (24), (25), (26), (27), (28), (29), (30), (31), (32), (33), (34), (35), (36). The
11 committees shall examine the strategic missions of each entity listed in
12 such subsections and shall determine where potential alignment may
13 occur.

14 (b) The committees shall develop recommendations on: (1)
15 Optimizing resources; (2) preventing needless redundancies in service; (3)
16 quantitatively evaluating how budgets and financial resources may be
17 shared across thematically similar entities; and (4) leveraging shared
18 resources among entities.

19 (c) Each committee shall be composed of 15 members. The general
20 industry regulatory committee shall be composed of members of the
21 entities listed in subsection (f). The public health and welfare regulatory
22 committee shall be composed of members of the entities listed in
23 subsection (g). The financial industry regulatory committee shall be
24 composed of members of the entities listed in subsection (h). No entity
25 shall have more than one member on such committee. The governor shall
26 appoint seven members to each committee. The speaker of the house of
27 representatives and the president of the senate shall each appoint two
28 members to each committee. The minority leader of the house of
29 representatives, the minority leader of the senate, the chairperson of the
30 house committee on appropriations and the chairperson of the senate
31 committee on ways and means shall each appoint one member to each
32 committee. On or after July 1, 2016, and once each year thereafter, each
33 committee shall meet to organize and elect a chairperson, who shall be a
34 legislative appointee and a vice-chairperson, who shall be a governor's
35 appointee.

The governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, the president of the senate, the minority leader of the house of representatives, the minority leader of the senate, the majority leader of the house of representatives, the majority leader of the senate, the chairperson of the house committee on appropriations and the chairperson of the senate committee on ways and means shall each appoint one member to each committee. All appointees shall be members of the legislature, except the governor's appointee. On or after July 1, 2016, the committee shall meet to organize and elect a chairperson, who shall be a legislative appointee and a vice-chairperson, who shall be the governor's appointee.

1 (d) No additional compensation, mileage, subsistence or any other
2 pay from state resources may be allowed for service on the committee.

3 (e) On or before January 1, 2017, and once each year thereafter, each
4 committee shall develop a written report requesting any executive or
5 legislative action necessary to accomplish the goals established in
6 subsections (a) and (b) and shall send such recommendation to the
7 governor, the president of the senate, the senate minority leader, the
8 speaker of the house of representatives and the house minority leader and
9 the director of legislative research.
