## MADAM PRESIDENT:

I move to amend **SB 372**, as amended by Senate Committee, on page 1, following line 10, by inserting:

"New Section 1. (a) The secretary for children and families and the secretary for aging and disability services, in consultation with and subject to approval by the secretary of state, shall develop a voter registration program to offer voter registration services through the following state agencies to recipients of public assistance:

- (1) The department for children and families; and
- (2) the department for aging and disability services.
- (b) At the time of making an application for assistance or benefits with the department for children and families or the department for aging and disability services, the applicant shall be offered the opportunity to register to vote.
- (c) If proof of citizenship was not required for the service applied for, the applicant shall be informed that proof of citizenship will be necessary to complete the process of registration to vote.
- (d) Voter registration applications shall be submitted to the secretary of state and the county election officers as provided by rules and regulations adopted by the secretary of state.
- (e) A person who is ineligible to vote and who becomes registered to vote under this section, in the absence of willful misrepresentation, shall be presumed to be not at fault and not subject to criminal prosecution.";
