HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

MR. CHAIRMAN:

I move to amend **Substitute for SB 99**, as amended by House Committee, on page 6, following line 8, by inserting:

"(4) In the case of a vehicle or combination of vehicles exclusively carrying grain or other seasonally harvested products during the normal harvest season from the field where they are harvested to storage, market or stockpile or from stockpile to market or factory up to 50 miles, the load may be up to: (A) 10% greater than the maximum weight shown in the table in this section for vehicles with tandem, triple or quad axles; or (B) 12.5% greater than the maximum weight shown in the table in this section for vehicles with a single rear axle. The provisions of this subsection (a)(4) do not apply to the national system of interstate and defense highways. For vehicles and combinations of vehicles, the maximum gross weight under this subsection (a)(4) shall not be more than 90,000 pounds. All vehicles and combination of vehicles under this subsection (a)(4) shall be required to obey all posted weight limits on roads and bridges."
