SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2120 by House Committee on Health and Human Services

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2120 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2120 would allow the State Board of Nursing to revoke a license for three years, and would establish a fee of \$1,000 for the reinstatement of a revoked license. The bill would also remove the requirement that the Kansas Federation of Licensed Practical Nurses submit a list of licensed practical nurses to the Office of the Governor.

The State Board of Nursing is unable to estimate the fiscal effect of HB 2120 because it is not known how many nurses would file a reinstatement application. The effect of the bill, however, is expected to be negligible.
