SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2263 by House Committee on Taxation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2263 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2263 would allow the Douglas County Commission to submit to voters the question of imposing an additional 0.5 percent countywide sales tax for the purpose of financing the costs of constructing, remodeling, or operating the courthouse, jail, law enforcement center facility, detention facility, mental health facility, or other county administration facility. The additional countywide sales tax would be permanent.

The Department of Revenue indicates HB 2263 would affect only local sales tax collections in Douglas County and would have no fiscal effect on state revenues. The Department indicates that the administrative costs associated with implementing the provisions of HB 2263 would be negligible and could be absorbed within existing resources.
