**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2268 by House Committee on Appropriations

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2268 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2268 would permit the Kansas State Historical Society to accept and hold the property known as the Last Chance Store in Council Grove, Kansas. The store would then become part of the Kaw Mission State Historic Site. The Historical Society would make the rules and regulations necessary for the use, enjoyment and government of the store.

According to the State Historical Society, passage of HB 2268 would have no fiscal effect on the agency as the current revenues and expenditures associated with the Kaw Mission would be consolidated with those of the Last Chance Store to support both sites. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2268 is not reflected in *The FY 2016 Governor's Budget Report*.
