SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2369 by House Committee on Appropriations

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2369 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2369 would prohibit any person under the age of 18 from accessing any tanning device at a tanning facility. The bill would establish a maximum fine of \$250 for any licensee found in violation of this new standard.

The Kansas Board of Cosmetology indicates there would be additional revenues generated by the fine established in the bill; however, the Board cannot estimate how much additional revenue the fine would generate, as the agency is unable to estimate how many violations would occur if HB 2369 were enacted. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2369 is not reflected in *The FY 2016 Governor's Budget Report*.
