SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2468 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2468 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2468 would prohibit a school district from adopting a policy that would prohibit an organization from conducting activities on school property solely because the activities include the possession and use of air guns by participants. In addition, a school district could not prohibit the possession of an air gun by a student on school property if the student is a participant in the activities of an organization.

Individuals participating in events that would have the use of an air gun on school property may be required to sign, or have a parent or legal guardian sign a liability waiver to relieve the district, school, and all school personnel from liability for any claims from activities involving air guns.

According to the Department of Education, enactment of HB 2468 would have no fiscal effect.
