In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 142 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 142 would exclude from the statutory definition of the term "adult care home" those centers approved by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services as a Program for All-inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) facility that provides services only to PACE participants.

Passage of SB 142 would have no fiscal effect on the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services.
