SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 341 by Senate Committee on Public Health and Welfare

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 341 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 341 would establish the Step Therapy Program for Medicaid patients administered by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment, Division of Health Care Finance (DHCF). Step therapy is the practice of beginning drug therapy for a medical condition with the most cost-effective drug, allowing a progression to other more costly drugs, if needed.
