SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 400 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 400 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 400 would prohibit any legislator serving on the Robert G. Bethel Joint Committee on Home and Community Based Services and KanCare Oversight from receiving any campaign contributions from any officer, director, or employee of any business that has a contract with the state to provide services for the KanCare program.

The Governmental Ethics Commission indicates that SB 400 would have no fiscal effect.
