1 AN ACT repealing K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 65-6230; concerning the health care
2 compact.

3 WHEREAS, Medicare plays a vital role in providing financial security
4 to older Kansans and those with disabilities; and

5 WHEREAS, 448,216 Kansans are covered by Medicare; and

6 WHEREAS, Medicare is paid for by payroll taxes paid by most
7 employees, employers and people who are self-employed; and

8 WHEREAS, the Health Care Compact creates a direct threat to the
9 health care of every older Kansan; and

10 WHEREAS, the Health Care Compact presents a real danger that state
11 officials will reduce or eliminate benefits currently covered under
12 Medicare.

13 Now, therefore:

14 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

15 Section 1. K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 65-6230 is hereby repealed.

16 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
17 publication in the statute book.
