AN ACT concerning state employees; relating to discretionary holiday leave.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. For calendar year 2016, and in each calendar year thereafter, each full-time employee of the state of Kansas shall receive one discretionary holiday in addition to the discretionary holiday designated by the governor pursuant to rules and regulations. Each eligible employee shall receive the number of hours equal to the number of hours that employee is regularly scheduled to work for such additional discretionary holiday. All laws, rules and regulations related to discretionary holidays and leave shall apply to such additional discretionary holiday. In order to be eligible for such additional discretionary holiday during the calendar year, such state employee shall have been employed full-time by the state of Kansas for all of the last preceding calendar year.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
