AN ACT concerning elections; dealing with the use of school buildings as polling places.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) All unified school districts shall make suitable school buildings available for polling places at the request of a county election officer for the county in which all or any portion of the school district is located.

- (b) The county election officer shall give not less than 60 days' notice to the superintendent of the school district of the need to use one or more school buildings as polling places for any primary or general election.
- (c) Any unified school district which has been notified that one or more of its school buildings will be needed as polling places shall schedule a training day for teachers on the date of the election.
- (d) The terms "primary election" and "general election" shall have the meanings as provided in K.S.A. 25-2502, and amendments thereto.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
