HOUSE BILL No. 2285

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1 AN ACT concerning the legislature; relating to legislative documents; 2 establishing the Kansas legislature paper-free task force; specifying 3 members and powers and duties. 4 5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:* 6 Section 1. (a) There is hereby established the Kansas legislature 7 paper-free task force which shall study and determine whether the Kansas 8 legislature should adopt a paperless initiative in order to reduce the 9 number of printed calendars, journals, bills, resolutions, reports and other legislative paperwork distributed to its legislative members, legislative 10 staff and to members of the public. In making such determination, the 11 12 Kansas legislature paper-free task force shall consider the following: 13 (1) The need to make such documents easily available to legislative 14 members and staff, members of the public, state libraries and other 15 interested parties: 16 (2) the need to protect the authenticity of and to preserve such 17 documents: 18 (3) the cost of distributing such documents electronically; and 19 (4) compliance by the Kansas legislature with the open meetings act 20 as provided in K.S.A. 75-4317 et seq., and amendments thereto, and the 21 open records act as provided in K.S.A. 45-215 et seq., and amendments 22 thereto. 23 (b) (1) The Kansas legislature paper-free task force shall be composed 24 of 16 members as follows: 25 (A) One member who is the chairperson of the joint committee on 26 information technology; 27 (B) one member who is a member of the legislature appointed by the 28 president of the senate; 29 (C) one member who is a member of the legislature appointed by the 30 vice president of the senate; 31 (D) one member who is a member of the legislature appointed by the 32 majority leader of the senate; (E) one member who is a member of the legislature appointed by the 33 34 minority leader of the senate; 35 (F) one member who is a member of the legislature appointed by the 36 speaker of the house of representatives;

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1 (G) one member who is a member of the legislature appointed by the 2 speaker pro tem of the house of representatives;

3 (H) one member who is a member of the legislature appointed by the majority leader of the house of representatives; 4

5 (I) one member who is a member of the legislature appointed by the 6 minority leader of the house of representatives;

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(J) the secretary of the senate or the secretary's designee;

8 (K) the chief clerk of the house of representatives or the chief clerk's 9 designee; 10

(L) the revisor of statutes or the revisor's designee;

(M) the director of legislative research or the director's designee;

(N) the director of legislative administrative services or the director's 12 13 designee;

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(O) the state librarian or the state librarian's designee; and

(P) the legislative chief information technology officer or the 15 16 legislative chief information technology officer's designee.

(2) The secretary of the senate, the chief clerk of the house of 17 representatives, the revisor of statutes, the director of legislative research, 18 19 the director of legislative administrative services, the state librarian and the 20 legislative chief information technology officer shall be non-voting, ex 21 officio members of the Kansas legislature paper-free task force.

22 (c) Appointments shall be made no later than August 1, 2015. All 23 vacancies in the membership of the committee shall be filled in the same 24 manner as originally filled.

25 (d) The initial meeting of the Kansas legislature paper-free task force shall be convened no later than September 1, 2015. The chairperson of the 26 joint committee on information technology shall be the chairperson of the 27 28 Kansas legislature paper-free task force.

29 (e) The Kansas legislature paper-free task force may meet at any time 30 on the call of the chairperson. A majority of members shall constitute a quorum. All actions of the council shall be by motion adopted by a 31 32 majority of those voting members present when there is a quorum.

33 (f) The staff of the office of revisor of statutes, the legislative research department and the division of legislative administrative services shall 34 35 provide such assistance as may be requested by the Kansas legislature 36 paper-free task force and to the extent authorized by the legislative 37 coordinating council.

38 (g) The legislative members of the Kansas legislature paper-free task 39 force shall be paid compensation, subsistence allowances, mileage and other expenses as provided by K.S.A. 75-3223, and amendments thereto. 40

(h) On or before the first day of the 2016 regular session of the 41 legislature, the Kansas legislature paper-free task force shall submit a 42 43 written report on its findings and recommendations to the legislature,

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- including, but not limited to, any recommendations for legislation. Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 2
- 3 publication in the statute book.
