1 AN ACT concerning property taxation; relating to the state-wide school
2 levy; amending section 11 of 2015 House Substitute for Senate Bill No.
3 7 and repealing the existing section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. Section 11 of 2015 House Substitute for Senate Bill No. 7
7 is hereby amended to read as follows: Sec. 11. (a) The board of education
8 of each school district shall levy an ad valorem tax upon the taxable
9 tangible property of the district at a rate of ~~20~~ 30 mills in school year
10 2015-2016 and school year 2016-2017 for the purpose of:

11 (1) Paying a portion of the costs of operating and maintaining public
12 schools in partial fulfillment of the constitutional obligation of the
13 legislature to finance the educational interests of the state; and

14 (2) with respect to any redevelopment district established prior to July
15 1, 1997, pursuant to K.S.A. 12-1771, and amendments thereto, paying a
16 portion of the principal and interest on bonds issued by cities under
17 authority of K.S.A. 12-1774, and amendments thereto, for the financing of
18 redevelopment projects upon property located within the district.

19 (b) Except for that portion of the proceeds used for the purpose
20 specified in subsection (a)(2), the proceeds from the tax levied by a school
21 district under authority of this section shall be remitted to the state
22 treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and
23 amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state
24 treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury and shall
25 credit the same to the state school finance fund.

26 (c) All moneys remitted to the state treasurer pursuant to subsection
27 (b) shall be used for paying a portion of the costs of operating and
28 maintaining public schools in partial fulfillment of the constitutional
29 obligation of the legislature to finance the educational interests of the state.

30 (d) No school district shall proceed under K.S.A. 79-1964, 79-1964a
31 or 79-1964b, and amendments thereto.

32 (e) The provisions of this section shall be effective from and after
33 July 1, 2015, through June 30, 2017.

34 Sec. 2. Section 11 of 2015 House Substitute for Senate Bill No. 7 is
35 hereby repealed.

36 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
