## HOUSE BILL No. 2449

AN ACT concerning the judicial branch; relating to severability of the provisions of 2015 House Bill No. 2005, chapter 81 of the 2015 Session Laws of Kansas; repealing K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 20-1a18.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. The provisions of 2015 House Bill No. 2005, chapter 81 of the 2015 Session Laws of Kansas, are severable. If any provision of 2015 House Bill No. 2005, chapter 81 of the 2015 Session Laws of Kansas, is held to be invalid or unconstitutional, the legislature declares by this act that the remainder of 2015 House Bill No. 2005, chapter 81 of the 2015 Session Laws of Kansas, shall remain in force and effect without such invalid or unconstitutional provision.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 20-1a18 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Kansas register.
