(a) Unlawfully tampering with electronic monitoring 8 equipment is, knowingly and without authorization, removing, disabling, 9 10 altering, tampering with, damaging or destroying any electronic 11 monitoring equipment used pursuant to court-ordered supervision or as a 12 condition of postrelease supervision or parole. 13 Unlawfully tampering with electronic monitoring equipment is a: (b) Severity level-6, nonperson felony in the case of electronic-14 (1)monitoring equipment used pursuant to court-ordered supervision or as a 15 condition of postrelease supervision or parole for any nondrug severity-16 level 1 through 5 felony or any drug severity level 1 or 2 felony; 17 18 (2) severity level 8, nonperson felony in the case of electronic 19 monitoring equipment used pursuant to court-ordered supervision or as a 20 condition of postrelease supervision or parole for any-nondrug severity-21 level 6 through 8 felony or any drug severity level 3 felony; and 22 (3) severity level 10, nonperson felony in the case of electronic-23 monitoring equipment used pursuant to court-ordered supervision or as a 24 condition of postrelease supervision or parole for any nondrug severity-25 level 9 or 10 felony, any nongrid felony or any drug severity level 4 or 5. 26 felonv: 27 (4) (2) class A nonperson misdemeanor in the case of electronic 28 monitoring equipment used pursuant to court-ordered supervision or as a 29 condition of postrelease supervision or parole for any misdemeanor or 30 used pursuant to court-ordered supervision in any civil case.
