AN ACT concerning elections; relating to ballots; removing city of
 residence from candidate information; amending K.S.A. 25-613 and
 25-617 and K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 25-616 and repealing the existing
 sections.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

7 Section 1. K.S.A. 25-613 is hereby amended to read as follows: 25-613. Except as otherwise provided in this section, the name of each 8 9 candidate shall be printed on the ballot only once and no name that is 10 printed on the ballot shall be written elsewhere on the ballot. If a person is 11 a candidate for the unexpired term for an office, such person's name may 12 be printed on the same ballot as a candidate of the same political party for 13 the next regular term for such office. Also, a person may be an 14 independent candidate for the unexpired term for an office and an independent candidate for the next regular term for such office, and the 15 16 person's name may be printed for both candidacies on the same official 17 general ballot. To the name of each candidate for a state office shall be-18 added the name of the eity in which the candidate resides. To the names of 19 pairs of candidates running for governor and lieutenant governor shall be 20 added the name of the city in which or near which each resides. To the 21 name of each candidate for any national, state, county or township offices 22 shall be added the person's political party or political designation in 23 accordance with the nomination papers of the person.


Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 25-616 is hereby amended to read as follows: 25-616. The secretary of state shall prescribe the ballot format but the national offices part of the official general ballot for national and state offices shall be substantially in the form shown in this section and the state offices part of such ballot shall be substantially in the form shown in K.S.A. 25-617, and amendments thereto.


