1	AN ACT relating to accountants; concerning professional licensure
2	requirements; early access to the certified public accountant
3	examination; amending K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 1-302a and repealing the
4	existing section.

6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
7	Section 1. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 1-302a is hereby amended to read as
8	follows: 1-302a. (a) The education requirement prescribed by K.S.A. 1-
9	302, and amendments thereto, is satisfied if the applicant meets all of the
10	following requirements:
11	(1) Is the holder of a baccalaureate or higher academic degree from a
12	college or university approved by the board;
13	(2) has been awarded credit by a college or university approved by
14	the board for at least 150 semester hours, with a concentration in
15	accounting; and
16	(3) the credit for the concentration in accounting is accepted by the
17	board.
18	(b) An applicant for admission to take the initial examination in this $x + x + y + y + y + y + y + y + y + y + $
19	state as required in K.S.A. 1-302, and amendments thereto, must submit
20	evidence satisfactory to the board or to the examination service that the
21	applicant <i>either</i> :
22	(1) Meets the requirements of subsection (a); or
23	(2) reasonably expects to meet the requirements of subsection (a)
24	within 60 days from the date the applicant takes the first section of such
25	examination. If all final official transcripts and any documents verifying
26	completion of such education requirements by the applicant are not
27	received by the board or the examination service within 90 days after the
28	applicant has taken the first section of the examination, the applicant's
29	grades for all sections of the examination shall be voided.
30	(c) The board may define, by rules and regulations, the term
31 32	"concentration in accounting." The board may also prescribe, by rules and regulations, the type and amount of credit submitted pursuant to subsection
32 33	(a).
