1 AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to registration fees; fee for
2 reflectorized license plates; creating the license plate manufacturing fee
3 fund; amending K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 8-143, 8-143j, 8-145 and 8-147 and
4 repealing the existing sections.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 New Section 1. There is hereby created in the state treasury the
8 license plate manufacturing fee fund. All moneys credited to the license
9 plate manufacturing fee fund shall be used by the department of revenue
10 only for the purpose of funding the administration, operation, training,
11 marketing, software maintenance and enhancement, equipment
12 maintenance and purchase, shipping or postage associated with the
13 issuance of vehicle registration license plates. All expenditures from the
14 license plate manufacturing fee fund shall be made in accordance with
15 appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports
16 issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the secretary of the department of
17 revenue.

18 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 8-143 is hereby amended to read as
19 follows: 8-143. (a) All applications for the registration of motorcycles,
20 motorized bicycles and passenger vehicles other than trucks and truck
21 tractors, except as otherwise provided, shall be accompanied by an annual
22 license fee as follows:

23 (1) For motorized bicycles, ~~\$11~~ \$13;
24 (2) for motorcycles, ~~\$16~~ \$18;
25 (3) for passenger vehicles, other than motorcycles, used solely for the
26 carrying of persons for pleasure or business, and for hearses and
27 ambulances a fee of:

28 (A) For those having a gross weight of 4,500 pounds or less, ~~\$30~~ \$32;
29 and

30 (B) for those having a gross weight of more than 4,500 pounds, ~~\$40~~
31 \$42.

32 (4) Except for motor vehicles, trailers or semitrailers registered under
33 the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,134, and amendments thereto, the annual
34 registration fee for each motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer owned by any
35 political or taxing subdivision of this state or by any agency or
36 instrumentality of any one or more political or taxing subdivisions of this

1 state and used exclusively for governmental purposes and not for any
2 private or utility purposes, which is not otherwise exempt from
3 registration, shall be ~~\$2~~ \$4.

4 (b) (1) As used in this subsection, the term "gross weight" shall mean
5 and include the empty weight of the truck, or combination of the truck or
6 truck tractor and any type trailer or semitrailer, plus the maximum weight
7 of cargo which will be transported on or with the same, except when the
8 empty weight of a truck plus the maximum weight of cargo which will be
9 transported thereon is 12,000 pounds or less. The term gross weight shall
10 not include: The weight of any travel trailer propelled thereby which is
11 being used for private recreational purposes; or the weight of any vehicle
12 or combination of vehicles for which wrecker or towing service, as defined
13 in K.S.A. 66-1329, and amendments thereto, is to be provided by a
14 wrecker or tow truck, as defined in K.S.A. 66-1329, and amendments
15 thereto. Such wrecker or tow truck shall be registered for the empty weight
16 of such vehicle fully equipped for the recovery or towing of vehicles. The
17 gross weight license fees hereinafter prescribed shall only apply to the
18 truck or truck tractor used as the propelling unit for the cargo and vehicle
19 propelled, either as a single vehicle or combination of vehicles. On
20 application for the registration of a truck or truck tractor, the owner thereof
21 shall declare as a part of such application the maximum gross weight the
22 owner desires to be applicable to such vehicle, which declared gross
23 weight in no event shall be in excess of the limitations described by K.S.A.
24 8-1908 and 8-1909, and amendments thereto, for such vehicle or
25 combination of vehicles of which it will be a part. All applications for the
26 registration of trucks or truck tractors, except as otherwise provided
27 herein, shall be accompanied by an annual license fee as follows:

32 (2) If the applicant for registration of any truck or truck tractor for a
 33 gross weight of more than 12,000 pounds is the state of Kansas or any
 34 political or taxing subdivision or agency of the state, except a city or
 35 county, whose truck or truck tractor is not otherwise entitled to the ~~\$2~~ \$4
 36 license fee or otherwise exempt from all fees, such vehicle may be
 37 licensed for a fee in accordance with the schedule hereinafter prescribed
 38 for local trucks or truck tractors.

39 (3) If the applicant for registration of any truck or truck tractor for a
 40 gross weight of more than 12,000 pounds shall under oath state in writing
 41 on a form prescribed and furnished by the director of vehicles that the
 42 applicant does not expect to operate it more than 6,000 miles in the
 43 calendar year for which the applicant seeks registration, and that if the

1 applicant shall operate it more than 6,000 miles during such registration
 2 year such applicant will pay an additional fee equal to the fee required by
 3 the schedule under paragraph (1), less the amount of the fee paid at time of
 4 registration, such vehicle may be licensed for a fee in accordance with the
 5 schedule prescribed for local trucks or truck tractors. Whenever a truck or
 6 truck tractor is registered on a local truck or truck tractor fee basis a tab or
 7 marker shall be issued in connection with the regular license plate, which
 8 tab or marker shall be attached or affixed to and displayed with the regular
 9 license plate and the failure to have the same attached, affixed or displayed
 10 shall be subject to the same penalties as provided by law for the failure to
 11 display the regular license plate; and the secretary of revenue may adopt
 12 rules and regulations requiring the owners of trucks and truck tractors so
 13 registered on a local truck or truck tractor fee basis to keep such records
 14 and make such reports of mileage of such vehicles as the secretary of
 15 revenue shall deem proper.

16 (4) A transporter delivering vehicles not the transporter's own by the
 17 driveaway method where such vehicles are being driven, towed, or
 18 transported singly, or by the saddlemount, towbar, or fullmount methods,
 19 or by any lawful combination thereof, may apply for license plates which
 20 may be transferred from one such vehicle or combination to another for
 21 each delivery without further registration, and the annual license fee for
 22 such license plate shall be as follows:

32 (5) A truck or truck tractor registered for a gross weight of more than
 33 12,000 pounds, which is operated wholly within the corporate limits of a
 34 city or village or within a radius of 25 miles beyond the corporate limits,
 35 shall be classified as a local truck except that in no event shall such
 36 vehicles operated as contract or common carriers outside a radius of three
 37 miles beyond the corporate limits of the city or village in which such
 38 vehicles were based when registered and licensed be considered local
 39 trucks or truck tractors. The secretary of revenue is hereby authorized and
 40 directed to adopt rules and regulations prescribing a procedure for the
 41 issuance of permits by the division of vehicles whereby owners of local
 42 trucks or truck tractors may operate any such vehicle, empty, beyond the
 43 radius hereinbefore prescribed, when such operation is solely for the

1 purpose of having such vehicle repaired, painted or serviced or for adding
2 additional equipment thereto. The annual license fee for a local truck or
3 truck tractor, except as otherwise provided herein, shall be as follows:

23 A vehicle licensed as a farm truck or truck tractor may be used by the

24 owner thereof to transport, for charity and without compensation of any

25 kind, commodities for religious or educational institutions. A truck which

26 is licensed as a farm truck may also be used for the transportation of sand,

27 gravel, slag stone, limestone, crushed stone, cinders, black top, dirt or fill

28 material to a township road maintenance or construction site of the

29 township in which the owner of such truck resides. Any applicant for

30 registration of any farm truck or farm truck tractor used in combination

31 with a trailer or semitrailer shall register the farm truck or farm truck

32 tractor for a gross weight which shall include the empty weight of the

33 truck or truck tractor or of the combination of any truck or truck tractor

34 and any type of trailer or semitrailer, plus the maximum weight of cargo

35 which will be transported on or with the same. The applicant for

36 registration of any farm truck or farm truck tractor used to transport a

37 gross weight of more than 54,000 pounds shall durably letter on the side of

38 the motor vehicle the words "farm vehicle—not for hire." If an applicant

39 for registration of any farm truck or farm truck tractor operates such

40 vehicle for any use or purpose not authorized for a farm truck or farm

41 truck tractor, such applicant shall pay an additional fee equal to the fee

42 required for the registration of all trucks or truck tractors not registered as

43 local, 6,000-mile or farm truck or farm truck tractor motor vehicles, less

1 the amount of the fee paid at time of registration. Nothing in this or the
2 preceding paragraph shall authorize a gross weight of a vehicle or
3 combination of vehicles on the national system of interstate and defense
4 highways greater than permitted by laws of the United States congress.

5 (7) Except as hereinafter provided, the annual license fee for each
6 local urban transit bus used in local urban transit operations exempted
7 under the provisions of ~~subsection (a) of K.S.A. 66-1,109(a)~~, and
8 amendments thereto, shall be based on the passenger seating capacity of
9 the bus and shall be as follows:

22 The annual license fee for each local urban transit bus which is owned
23 by a metropolitan transit authority established pursuant to articles 25 and
24 28 of chapter 12 or pursuant to article 31 of chapter 13 of the Kansas

26 (8) For licensing purposes, station wagons with a carrying capacity of
27 less than 10 passengers shall be subject to registration fees based on the
28 weight of the vehicles, as provided in subsection (a). Station wagons with
29 a carrying capacity of 10 or more passengers shall be subject to the truck
30 classifications and license fees as provided.

31 (9) For any trailer, semitrailer, travel trailer or pole trailer the annual
32 license fee shall be as follows:

1 Any such vehicle having a gross weight of 2,000 pounds or less may, at
2 the owner's option, be registered and the fee for such registration shall be
3 as provided in paragraph (C).

4 Any trailer, semitrailer or travel trailer owned by a nonresident of this
5 state and based in another state, which is properly registered and licensed
6 in the state of residence of the owner or in the state where based, may be
7 operated in this state without being registered or licensed in this state if the
8 truck or truck tractor propelling the same is properly registered and
9 licensed in this state, or is registered and licensed in some other state and
10 is entitled to reciprocal privileges of operation in this state, but this
11 provision shall not apply to any trailer or semitrailer owned by a
12 nonresident of this state when such trailer or semitrailer is owned by a
13 person who has proportionately registered and licensed a fleet of vehicles
14 under the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,101 to 8-1,123, inclusive, and
15 amendments thereto, or under the terms of any reciprocal or proration
16 agreement made pursuant thereto.

17 At the option of the owner, any trailer, semitrailer or pole trailer, with a
18 gross weight of more than 12,000 pounds, may be issued a multi-year
19 registration for a five-year period upon payment of the appropriate
20 registration fee. The fee for a five-year registration of such trailer shall be
21 five times the annual fee for such trailer. If the annual registration fee is
22 increased during the multi-year registration period, the owner of the trailer
23 with such multi-year registration shall be subject to the amount of the
24 increase of the annual registration fee for the remaining calendar years of
25 such multi-year registration. When the owner of any trailer, semitrailer or
26 pole trailer registered under this multi-year provision transfers or assigns
27 the title, or interest thereto, the registration of such trailer shall expire. The
28 owner shall remove the license plate from such trailer and forward the
29 license plate to the division of vehicles or may have such license plate
30 assigned to another trailer, semitrailer or pole trailer upon the payment of
31 fees required by law. Any owner of a trailer, semitrailer or pole trailer
32 where the multi-year registration fee has been paid and the trailer is sold,
33 junked, repossessed, foreclosed by a mechanic's lien or title transferred by
34 operation of law, and the registration thereon is not going to be transferred
35 to another trailer, may secure a refund for the registration fee for the
36 remaining calendar years by making application to the division of vehicles
37 on a form and in the manner prescribed by the director of vehicles. The
38 secretary of revenue may adopt such rules and regulations necessary to
39 implement the multi-year registration of such trailers, semitrailers and pole
40 trailers.

41 (c) Any truck or truck tractor having a gross weight of 4,000 pounds
42 or over, using solid tires, shall pay a license fee of double the amount
43 herein charged. The annual fees herein provided for trucks, truck tractors

1 and trailers not subject to K.S.A. 8-134a, and amendments thereto, shall be
2 due January 1 of each year and payable on or before the last day of
3 February in each year. If the fee is not paid by such date a penalty of \$1
4 shall be added to the fee charged herein for each month or fraction thereof

14 penalties, applicable at the time the application is made. If any motorcycle,
15 motorized bicycle, trailer, semitrailer, travel trailer, or pole trailer is either
16 purchased or acquired after the anniversary or renewal date in any
17 registration year there shall immediately become due and payable a
18 registration fee as follows: If purchased or acquired between the
19 anniversary or renewal date of any registration year and the first six
20 months of such registration year, the annual fee hereinbefore provided; if
21 purchased or acquired during the last six months of any registration year,
22 50% of such annual fee. If any truck or truck tractor, except trucks subject
23 to K.S.A. 8-134a, and amendments thereto, is purchased or acquired prior
24 to April 1 of any year the fee shall be the annual fee hereinbefore provided,
25 but if such truck or truck tractor is purchased or acquired after the end of
26 March of any year, the license fee for such year shall be reduced $\frac{1}{12}$ for
27 each calendar month which has elapsed since the beginning of the year. If
28 any truck registered for a gross weight of 12,000 pounds or less or
29 passenger vehicle is purchased or acquired and less than 12 months remain
30 in the registration period, the fee shall be $\frac{1}{12}$ of the annual fee for each
31 calendar month remaining in the registration period.

32 (d) The owner of any motorcycle, motorized bicycle, passenger
33 vehicle, truck, truck tractor, trailer, semitrailer, or electrically propelled
34 vehicle who fails to pay the registration fee or fees herein provided on the
35 date when the same become due and payable shall be guilty of a
36 misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be subject to a penalty in
37 the sum of \$1 for each month or fraction thereof during which such fee has
38 remained unpaid after it became due and payable; and in addition thereto
39 shall be subject to such other punishment as is provided in this act. Upon
40 the transfer of motorcycles, motorized bicycles, passenger vehicles,

6 registration shall be accompanied by a fee of \$1.50. When the registration
7 of a vehicle has expired at midnight on the last day of any registration
8 year, and such vehicle is not thereafter operated upon the highways, any
9 application for renewal of registration made subsequent to the anniversary
10 or renewal date of any registration year following the expiration of such
11 registration and for succeeding registration years in which such vehicle has
12 not been registered shall be accompanied by an affidavit of nonoperation
13 and nonuse, and such application for renewal or registration shall be
14 received by the division of vehicles upon payment of the proper fees for

16 (e) Any nonresident of Kansas purchasing a vehicle from a Kansas
17 resident and desiring to secure registration on the vehicle in the state of

21 sales tax has been paid, if due, shall charge and collect a fee of \$3 for each
22 sixty-day temporary license and issue a sticker or paper registration as may

25 (f) Any owner of any motor vehicle which is subject to taxation under

28 annual registration fee has been paid and the vehicle is sold, junked,
29 repossessed, foreclosed by a mechanic's lien or title transferred by
30 operation of law, and the registration thereon is not going to be transferred
31 to another vehicle may secure a refund for the registration fee for the
32 remaining portion of the year by making application to the division of
33 vehicles on a form and in the manner prescribed by the director of
34 vehicles, accompanied by all license plates and attachments issued in
35 connection therewith. If the owner of the registration becomes deceased
36 and the vehicle is not going to be used on the highway, and title is not
37 being currently transferred, the proper representative of the estate shall be
38 entitled to the refund. The refund shall be made only for the period of time
39 remaining in the registration year from the date of completion and filing of
40 the application with and delivery of the license plate and attachments to
41 the division of vehicles. Where the registration is secured under a quarterly
42 payment annual registration fee, as provided for in K.S.A. 8-143a, and
43 amendments thereto, such refund shall be made on the quarterly fee paid

1 and unused and all remaining quarterly payments shall be canceled. Any
