Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 48-3601 is hereby amended to read as 7 follows: 48-3601. (a)-(1) A current member of the armed forces of the 8 United States or the member's spouse or dependent child who is enrolled 9 or has been accepted for admission at a postsecondary educational 10 institution as a postsecondary student shall be deemed to be a resident of 11 the state for the purpose of tuition and fees for attendance at such 12 postsecondary educational institution.

13 (2) (b) A person is entitled to pay tuition and fees at an institution of 14 higher education at the rates provided for Kansas residents without regard 15 to the length of time the person has resided in the state if the person:

16 (1) (A) Files a letter of intent to establish residence in the state with 17 the postsecondary educational institution at which the person intends to 18 register; (B) lives in the state while attending the postsecondary 19 educational institution—and the person; and (C) is eligible for benefits 20 under the federal post-9/11 veterans educational assistance act of 2008, 38 21 U.S.C. § 3301 et seq., or any other federal law authorizing educational 22 benefits for veterans;

(2) (A) is a veteran; (B) was<u>present</u> permanently stationed in
Kansas during service in the armed forces<u>for a period of time not less</u>
than two years or had established residency in Kansas prior to service in
the armed forces; and (C) lives in Kansas at the time of enrollment; or

(3) (A) is the spouse or dependent of a veteran who was-present
permanently stationed in Kansas during such veteran's service in the
armed forces-for a period of time not less than two years or had
established residency in Kansas prior to service in the armed forces; and
(B) lives in Kansas at the time of enrollment.

(b) (c) As used in this section:

(1) "Armed forces" means the army, navy, marine corps, air force,
 coast guard, Kansas army or air national guard or any branch of the

1 military reserves of the United States;

2 (2) "postsecondary educational institution" means the same as 3 provided in K.S.A. 74-3201b, and amendments thereto; and

4 (3) "school year 2015-2016" means July 1, 2015 through June 30, 5 2016; and

6 (4) "veteran" means a person who has been separated from the armed 7 forces and was honorably discharged or received a general discharge under 8 honorable conditions.

9 (d) Any person enrolled in a postsecondary educational institution at any time during school year 2015-2016 who would have been entitled to 10 tuition and fee rates for a Kansas resident pursuant to subsection (b)(2) or 11 (3) had such subsection been in effect, but who-who paid more than such 12 tuition and fee rates for school year 2015-2016 shall be entitled to 13 reimbursement of the difference between any tuition and fee rates such 14 person paid for school year 2015-2016 and the tuition and fee rate such 15 16 person would have paid as a Kansas resident if such subsection had been 17 in effect.

(e) (e) This section shall be part of and supplemental to chapter 48 of
 the Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto.
