## SENATE BILL No. 127

AN ACT concerning<u>memorial highways</u> roads and bridges; relating to 1 2 **commemorative** signage; requiring the secretary of transportation to 3 collect sufficient funds prior to installation; designating the 2<sup>nd</sup> 4 Lieutenant Justin L Sisson memorial highway, the George Ablah 5 expressway-and, the Kenneth W Bernard memorial highway, the Clay county Vietnam veterans bridge and the Bert Cantwell memorial 6 7 interchange; amending K.S.A. 68-1034 and K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 68-8 10,106 and repealing the existing sections.

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10 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

New Section 1. On and after July 1, 2015, the secretary of 11 transportation shall not place any signs commemoratively designating any 12 highway, bridge, interchange or trail until the secretary has received 13 14 sufficient moneys from gifts and donations to reimburse the secretary for the cost of placing such signs and an additional 50% of the initial cost to 15 defray future maintenance or replacement costs of such signs. The 16 17 secretary of transportation may accept and administer gifts and donations to aid in obtaining and installing suitable signs. 18

19 New Sec. 2. That portion of United States highway 69 from the 20 junction of United States highway 69 and 135<sup>th</sup> street in Johnson county, then south on United States highway 69 to the junction of United States 21 highway 69 and  $167^{th}$  street is hereby designated as the  $2^{nd}$  Lieutenant 22 Justin L Sisson memorial highway. The secretary of transportation shall 23 24 place highway signs along the highway right-of-way at proper intervals to indicate that the highway is the  $2^{nd}$  Lieutenant Justin L Sisson 25 26 memorial highway, except that such signs shall not be placed until the 27 secretary has received sufficient moneys from gifts and donations to reimburse the secretary for the cost of placing such signs and an 28 29 additional 50% of the initial cost to defray future maintenance or 30 replacement costs of such signs. The secretary of transportation may 31 accept and administer gifts and donations to aid in obtaining and 32 installing suitable signs.

New Sec. 3. The portion of K-96 highway from the junction with interstate highway 135 then east to the junction with Rock Road in 1 Sedgwick county is hereby designated as the George Ablah expressway.

The secretary of transportation shall place<u>markers</u> highway signs along 2 the highway right-of-way at proper intervals to indicate that the highway 3 is the George Ablah expressway, except that such signs shall not be 4 placed until the secretary has received sufficient moneys from gifts and 5 6 donations to reimburse the secretary for the cost of placing such signs 7 and an additional 50% of the initial cost to defray future maintenance or replacement costs of such signs. The secretary of transportation may 8 accept and administer gifts and donations to aid in obtaining and 9 10 installing suitable signs.

Sec. 4. K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 68-10,106 is hereby amended to read as 11 follows: 68-10,106. The portion of K-96 highway from the junction with 12 interstate highway 135 Rock Road in Sedgwick county then east to the 13 junction with interstate highway 35 is hereby designated as the Bonnie 14 Huy memorial highway. The secretary of transportation shall place 15 16 markers along the highway right-of-way at proper intervals to indicate 17 that the highway is the Bonnie Huy memorial highway, except that such signs shall not be placed until the secretary has received sufficient 18 19 moneys from gifts and donations to reimburse the secretary for the cost 20 of placing such signs and an additional 50% of the initial cost to defray 21 future maintenance or replacement costs of such signs. The secretary of 22 transportation may accept and administer gifts and donations to aid in 23 obtaining and installing suitable signs.

That portion of K-7 highway from the southern city 24 New Sec. 5. limits of the city of Lansing then north on K-7 highway to the northern 25 city limits of the city of Lansing is hereby designated as the Kenneth W 26 Bernard memorial highway. The secretary of transportation shall place 27 highway signs along the highway right-of-way at proper intervals to 28 indicate that the highway is the Kenneth W Bernard memorial highway, 29 except that such signs shall not be placed until the secretary has received 30 sufficient moneys from gifts and donations to reimburse the secretary 31 for the cost of placing such signs and an additional 50% of the initial 32 cost to defray future maintenance or replacement costs of such signs. 33 The secretary of transportation may accept and administer gifts and 34 35 donations to aid in obtaining and installing suitable signs.

Sec. 6. K.S.A. 68-1034 is hereby amended to read as follows: 68-36 37 1034. From the junction of United States highway 24 and United States 38 highway 40 with United States highway 73 and highway K-7, United 39 States highway 73 and highway K-7 north to the southern city limits of Lansing, then north from the northern city limits of Lansing to the eastern 40 junction with United States highway 59 in the city of Atchison, United 41 States highway 73 west to the junction with United States highway 159, 42 43 is hereby designated as the Amelia Earhart memorial highway. The

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1 secretary of transportation shall place markers along the highway right-

2 of-way at proper intervals to indicate that the highway is the Amelia
3 Earhart memorial highway. The secretary of transportation may accept
4 and administer gifts and donations to aid in obtaining suitable highway
5 signs bearing the proper approved inscription.

6 New Sec. 7. Bridge no. 14(030) on Kansas highway 15 in Clay 7 county is hereby designated as the Clay county Vietnam veterans bridge. The secretary of transportation shall place suitable signs to 8 9 indicate the bridge is the Clay county Vietnam veterans bridge, except 10 that such signs shall not be placed until the secretary has received sufficient moneys from gifts and donations to reimburse the secretary 11 12 for the cost of placing such signs and an additional 50% of the initial 13 cost to defray future maintenance or replacement costs of such signs. The secretary of transportation may accept and administer gifts and 14 15 donations to aid in obtaining and installing suitable signs.

New Sec. 8. The junction of interstate highway 70 and 110<sup>th</sup> 16 17 street in Wyandotte county is hereby designated as the Bert Cantwell 18 memorial interchange. The secretary of transportation shall place signs along the highway right-of-way at proper intervals to indicate 19 20 that the junction of interstate highway 70 and 110 street is the Bert 21 Cantwell memorial interchange, except that such signs shall not be 22 placed until the secretary has received sufficient moneys from gifts 23 and donations to reimburse the secretary for the cost of placing such 24 signs and an additional 50% of the initial cost to defray future 25 maintenance or replacement costs of such signs. The secretary of 26 transportation may accept and administer gifts and donations to aid in 27 obtaining and installing suitable signs.

28 Sec.<u>-7.</u> 9. K.S.A. 68-1034 and K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 68-10,106 are 29 hereby repealed.
