AN ACT concerning the disposition of district court fines, penalties and
forfeitures; relating to the criminal justice information system line fund;
amending K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 74-7336 and repealing the existing
section.
Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
Section 1. K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 74-7336 is hereby amended to read as
follows: 74-7336. (a) Of the remittances of fines, penalties and forfeitures
received from clerks of the district court, at least monthly, the state
treasurer shall credit:
(1) $10.94\%$ to the crime victims compensation fund;
(2) 2.24% to the crime victims assistance fund;
(3) 2.75% to the community alcoholism and intoxication programs
fund;
(4) 7.65% to the department of corrections alcohol and drug abuse
treatment fund;
(5) $0.16\%$ to the boating fee fund;
(6) $0.11\%$ to the children's advocacy center fund;
(7) 2.28% to the EMS revolving fund;
(8) $2.28\%$ to the trauma fund;
(9) $2.28\%$ to the traffic records enhancement fund;
(10) $2.91\%$ 4.4% to the criminal justice information system line
fund; and
(11) the remainder of the remittances to the state general fund.
(b) The county treasurer shall deposit grant moneys as provided in
subsection (a), from the crime victims assistance fund, to the credit of a
special fund created for use by the county or district attorney in
establishing and maintaining programs to aid witnesses and victims of
crime.
Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 74-7336 is hereby repealed.
Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
publication in the statute book.
