AN ACT concerning railroads; relating to operation and movement; requiring two employees; penalties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) No train, locomotive or light engine used in connection with the movement of freight may be operated unless it has a crew consisting of at least two individuals. As used in this section, "train, locomotive or light engine used in connection with the movement of freight" shall not include hostler service or utility employees.

- (b) Violation of this section is punishable by a fine:
- (1) Not less than \$250 nor more than \$1,000, except as provided further;
- (2) not less than \$1,000 nor more than \$5,000 for a second conviction within three years immediately preceding the violation; or
- (3) not less than \$5,000 nor more than \$10,000 for a third or subsequent conviction within three years immediately preceding the violation.

For purposes of this subsection, the number of violations within five years shall be measured by the date the violations occur.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
