Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. Cowley county is the home of 18 laid stone arch bridges built before 1910, 17 of which are still traveled by daily traffic. Cowley county is hereby designated as the official "stone bridge capital" of the state of Kansas.
