AN ACT concerning income taxation; relating to eligibility for tax credits; 1 2 social security numbers; amending K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 79-32,265 and repealing the existing section. 3 4 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 79-32,265 is hereby amended to read as 6 7 follows: 79-32,265. Except as otherwise provided, no credit provided 8 under the Kansas income tax act, and amendments thereto, shall be 9 allowed any individual who fails to provide a valid social security number issued to such individual, the individual's spouse and dependents of the 10 11 individual for purposes of section 205 (c)(2)(A) of the social security act 12 on such individual's Kansas income tax return as the identifying number 13 for such individual for tax purposes or any individual who has not been issued a valid social security number for the entire taxable year in which 14 such credit is claimed. The provisions of this section shall not apply to the 15 16 credit provided by K.S.A. 79-32,111, and amendments thereto.
