AN ACT concerning the local food and farm task force; extending the 1 2 expiration date; amending K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 2-3805 and repealing the 3 existing section. 4 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 2-3805 is hereby amended to read as 7 follows: 2-3805.(a) There is hereby established the local food and farm-8 task force. The local food and farm task force shall be comprised of seven 9 members, as follows: 10 (1) Three members appointed by the governor, including the-11 chairperson of the task force; 12 (2) one member representing the Kansas department of agriculture 13 appointed by the secretary of agriculture; (3) one member representing the Kansas state university extension 14 systems and agriculture research programs appointed by the dean of the 15 college of agriculture of Kansas state university; and 16 (4) one member of the house committee on agriculture and natural 17 resources appointed by the chairperson of the house committee on-18 19 agriculture and natural resources and one member of the senate committee 20 on agriculture appointed by the chairperson of the senate committee on agriculture. The legislative members shall be from different political-21 22 parties. 23 (b) Members shall be appointed to the task force on or before August 1, 2014. The first meeting of the task force shall be called by the-24 25 ehairperson on or before September 1, 2014. Any vacancy in the-26 membership of the task force shall be filled by appointment in the same 27 manner prescribed by this section for the original appointment. 28 (c) (1) The task force may meet at any time and at any place within 29 the state on the call of the chairperson. A quorum of the task force shall be 30 four members. All actions of the task force shall be by motion adopted by 31 a majority of those members present when there is a quorum. 32 (2) The staff of the Kansas department of agriculture and the 33 legislative research department shall provide such assistance as may be 34 requested by the task force. To facilitate the organization and start-up of 35 such plan and structure, the Kansas department of agriculture shall provide 36 administrative assistance.

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(d) The local food and farm task force shall prepare a local food and 1 farm plan containing policy and funding recommendations for expanding 2 and supporting local food systems and for assessing and overcoming-3 obstacles necessary to increase locally grown food production. The task 4 force chairperson shall submit such plan to the senate committee on-5 agriculture and the house committee on agriculture and natural resources 6 at the beginning of the 2016 regular session of the legislature. The plan-7 8 shall include.

9 (1) Identification of financial opportunities, technical support and 10 training necessary for local and specialty crop production;

11 (2) identification of strategies and funding needs to make fresh and 12 affordable locally grown foods more accessible;

(3) identification of existing local food infrastructures for processing,
 storing and distributing food and recommendations for potential
 expansion; and

(4) strategies for encouragement of farmers' markets, roadside markets and local grocery stores in unserved and underserved areas.

(e) The task force shall cease to exist on December 31, 2015.

(a) There is hereby established the local food and farm task force. The
local food and farm task force shall be comprised of seven members, as
follows:

22 (1) Three members appointed by the governor, including the 23 chairperson of the task force;

(2) one member representing the Kansas department of agriculture
 appointed by the secretary of agriculture;

(3) one member representing the Kansas state university extension
systems and agriculture research programs appointed by the dean of the
college of agriculture of Kansas state university; and

(4) one member of the house committee on agriculture and natural
resources appointed by the chairperson of the house committee on
agriculture and natural resources and one member of the senate
committee on agriculture appointed by the chairperson of the senate
committee on agriculture. The legislative members shall be from different
political parties.

(b) Members shall be appointed to the task force on or before August
1, 2016. The first meeting of the task force shall be called by the
chairperson on or before September 1, 2016, or as soon as appointments
are made. Any vacancy in the membership of the task force shall be filled
by appointment in the same manner prescribed by this section for the
original appointment.

41 (c) (1) The task force may meet at any time and at any place within
42 the state on the call of the chairperson. A quorum of the task force shall be
43 four members. All actions of the task force shall be by motion adopted by a

1 majority of those members present when there is a quorum.

2 (2) The staff of the Kansas department of agriculture and the 3 legislative research department shall provide such assistance as may be 4 requested by the task force. To facilitate the organization and start-up of 5 such plan and structure, the Kansas department of agriculture shall 6 provide administrative assistance.

7 (3) Members of the task force attending regular or special meetings 8 or subcommittee meetings authorized by the task force shall be paid 9 amounts for mileage as provided by K.S.A. 75-3223(c), and amendments 10 thereto.

11 (d) The local food and farm task force shall prepare a local food and 12 farm plan containing policy and funding recommendations for expanding and supporting local food systems and for assessing and overcoming 13 obstacles necessary to increase locally grown food production. The task 14 force chairperson shall submit such plan to the senate committee on 15 16 agriculture and the house committee on agriculture and natural resources at the beginning of the 2017 regular session of the legislature. The plan 17 18 shall include:

(1) Identification of financial opportunities, technical support and
 training necessary for local and specialty crop production;

(2) identification of strategies and funding needs to make fresh and
 affordable locally grown foods more accessible;

(3) identification of existing local food infrastructures for processing,
 storing and distributing food and recommendations for potential
 expansion; and

(4) strategies for encouragement of farmers' markets, roadside
 markets and local grocery stores in unserved and underserved areas.

- 29 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 2-3805 is hereby repealed.
- 30 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 31 publication in the Kansas register.
