AN ACT concerning school districts; creating the Jason Flatt act; requiring suicide prevention training for school district personnel.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

- Section 1. (a) This section shall be known and may be cited as the Jason Flatt act.
- (b) The state board of education shall require that all teachers and principals licensed or certified by the state board of education annually receive at least two hours of suicide prevention training. The suicide prevention training shall use best practice-based programs recommended by the state board of education. The suicide prevention training may be satisfied through independent self-review of suicide prevention training material.
- (c) On or before January 1, 2017, the state board of education shall adopt rules and regulations necessary to implement the provisions of this section.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
