AN ACT concerning governmental ethics; relating to use of public funds for lobbying.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Every lobbyist shall file with the secretary of state a detailed report of all public funds received by such lobbyist from a governmental entity. The report shall include a listing of the amount of public funds paid to hire or contract for the services of such lobbyist on a form and in the manner prescribed and provided by the governmental ethics commission. Each report required to be filed by this section is a public record and shall be open to public inspection upon request. A report shall be filed on or before the 10<sup>th</sup> day of January for the reporting period containing the preceding calendar year. Such report shall disclose an itemized listing of all public funds received by any such lobbyist.

- (b) The reports filed with the secretary of state pursuant to subsection (a) shall be made available on a publicly searchable website by the secretary of state.
  - (c) As used in this section:
- (1) "Governmental entity" has the meaning as defined in K.S.A. 75-6102, and amendments thereto.
- (2) "Lobbying" has the meaning as defined in K.S.A. 46-225, and amendments thereto.
  - (3) "Public funds" means money appropriated by the state or any of its subdivisions having the authority to levy and collect taxes.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
